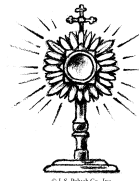
**FROM THE BLESSED SACRAMENT CHAPEL**

On the first Easter evening, the disciples Jesus met on the road to Emmaus urged him to stay with them - without recognizing him. When he blessed and broke the bread and gave it to them, St. Luke recounts, "With that, their eyes were opened, and they recognized him but he vanished from their sight." (24:31) Did those disciples see a seed of Eucharistic adoration being planted? Today we don't see Jesus in the flesh, as the Emmaus disciples first did, but we do see him in his Eucharistic presence at Mass, we know he's in the tabernacle, and we look upon him in a monstrance for adoration. We have a priceless treasure here at the chapel - could you find one hour a week to spend with Jesus?

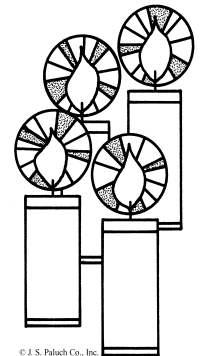

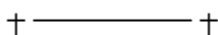

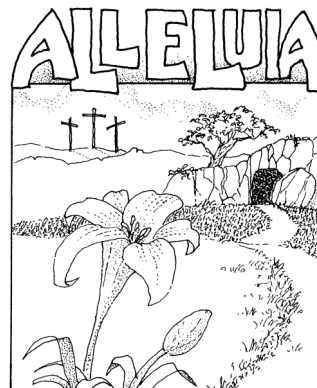
