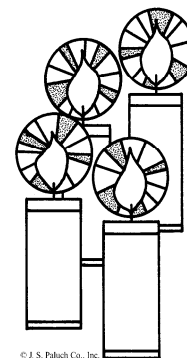

Technology news

We are in the final stages of changing over from NCS eGiving services to eCatholic Payment electronic giving services. There are several reasons for this change:

1. NCS service was not meeting our support requirements. There were support issues both at the administrative level as well as several users.
2. eCatholic Payment services is fully integrated with our website provider. It's not a separate entity. It's being integrated directly into our secure website.
3. Improved Service transaction fees:
 - a. eCatholic website hosting and Payment service fees are waived as part of the Diocesan level support from eCatholic.
 - b. The percentage fee per transaction charged by eCatholic Payments for processing is 1/2 the cost per transaction.
 - c. The user login is simplified and provides FULL control of your donation: frequency, amount, and accounts to charge.

eCatholic provides full support for both Parish Administrators as well as eCatholic Payment users.

We recognize that there were support issues with NCS eGiving and are committed to make sure this doesn't happen with eCatholic Payments.
