RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students are to be respectful and courteous at all times to teachers, office staff, and fellow students. Violence or threats of any kind towards any person will not be tolerated, nor will disrespect or unnecessary interruptions during class times.
2. Students are expected to arrive to class **on time no later than 9:45 AM**. No student will be dismissed early without a signed note from their parent or guardian. Any early dismissal notes must be presented to the teacher or office before class begins. All Students are also expected to attend Mass as part of their Religious Education. The Mass at 11:00 AM directly after classes end is our Family Mass and it is our intention that all students will attend this Mass each and every week with their family. If you wish to attend Mass at a different time, weekend Masses are held on Saturday at 4:00 PM and on Sunday at 8:00 and 11:00 AM.
3. Appropriate dress is required of all students. Please keep in mind that classes are held in Church and students will be sent home if they are wearing inappropriate clothing.
4. Cell phones, ipods, etc are not to be used during class.

Any student in violation of any of the rules will be sent to the office and the parent/guardian will be called. If the violation is of a serious or reoccurring nature, a mandatory meeting with the student, parent(s), religious education board and pastor will be scheduled and the student may face expulsion.

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Prevention & Healing Department

In response to the crisis of the sexual abuse of children by clergy in the Catholic Church, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCD) drafted a landmark document in Dallas, Texas, at its 2002 summer assembly. In this statement, the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People (the Charter), the bishops recommit themselves to victims/survivors and their families and to each other in order to ensure—to the best of their abilities—that sexual abuse of minors within the Church will never happen again. A comprehensive set of procedures to address allegations of sexual abuse of minors by Catholic clergy, the Charter includes guidelines for reconciliation, healing, accountability, and prevention of future acts of abuse.
