

The Most Holy Trinity

Dear Parishioners,

Perhaps you have already heard the news that Fr. John Madigan has been asked by the Archbishop to serve at Sacred Heart Parish in Bellevue. We will miss Fr. John's presence in our parish and we wish him well on this new assignment. With Fr. John's departure and a change of my day off we will be making some adjustment to the daily mass schedule starting July 1st. We'll make that new schedule available soon.

I am happy to announce that we have signed a contract to have the upper parking lots re-surfaced and striped in July. This is made possible through the generosity of the school auction and a generous parishioner.

Someone asked me after one of the Masses, “What is your plan for the parish, where are you taking it?” It is the plan of the early Church. It is what happened at Pentecost. It is what I shared in my homily last week about the powerful action of the Holy Spirit which moved the Apostles and the early Church to such great growth and to follow Christ's mandate to go out and make disciples of the entire world. My Plan is Eucharistic centered discipleship. Discipleship is where each person comes to a personal and intimate knowledge and love of Jesus Christ and his Gospel. Discipleship means developing a strong interior life rooted and growing in prayer and devotion (e.g., the rosary, Eucharistic adoration, spiritual reading, etc.). From the interior life comes ongoing conversion, through which we become the best version of ourselves. Conversion leads to discernment, which answers the question, “What does the Holy Spirit want me to do with my life, talents and resources? Discernment leads to service, the bearing of fruit, and charity that Our Lord expects of us and for which we will be accountable. For Christ, sitting on the sidelines is not an option, we are called to play, engage.

In a community like Holy Rosary there are many opportunities to serve. Please prayerfully consider some of these opportunities. We need volunteers to help in the nursery at the 9 and 11 o'clock Masses in the fall. We are always looking for more readers, Extraordinary Eucharistic ministers, and ushers. In the fall we will begin “Koinonia” an evening of Dinner, Discipleship, and Devotion for everyone. We will need many volunteers to help with this. Please contact Timothy Putnam who is our Faith Formation and Evangelization Director to help.

“Koinonia” names the kind of community that naturally builds disciples. The word appears 19 times in most editions of the Greek New Testament. It is variously translated “fellowship”, “sharing”, “participation” and “contribution”. This kind of community flows from the Eucharist, which is the sacrament of communion with one another in the one body of Christ. As we experience intimacy with Christ and unity with one another in the Eucharist, we have the opportunity to deepen our relationships with one another in service to our community. Make plans to participate in Koinonia this fall, and prayerfully discern how God may ask you to contribute to its success. Koinonia is the giving of the gift together. It is a way to give what we have received.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

INFANT BAPTISM - Parents and godparents attend one session to prepare to celebrate this sacrament. We encourage parents to attend before the birth or adoption of their child. Please call the Parish Office at least **six weeks prior to the desired Baptism date** to register your child. **Next preparation class** is on **July 22nd, 2018 beginning with Mass at 11AM and ending by 2:30PM**. Please call the Parish Office to register. Upcoming baptisms are on **June 10th, July 8th, and August 12, 2018**. Baptisms are scheduled with Father Vincent on the ***second Sunday of the month, after the 11AM Mass***. Parishioners who prefer to have the Baptism at “their” regular mass time may make that request through the parish office.

MARRIAGE - Couples wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the parish **at least 6 months** prior to the desired date. Preparation for celebrating and living the sacrament is required. Catholics are to be confirmed prior to celebrating marriage. Contact Roberta Tassani for more information.

ANOIDTING OF THE SICK - is celebrated any time there is a serious illness or health crisis. Contact the parish office to make arrangements.

FUNERALS - Please contact the parish after a death, and before making arrangements with a funeral home.

CONFIRMATION - The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated yearly for those who are age 16 or older. Attendance at preparation sessions is required. Contact the Parish office or email kellyg@holyrosaryedmonds.org for information. Adults who have not been confirmed may also celebrate the sacrament, which is a requirement for the Sacrament of Marriage and a prerequisite to be a godparent. Contact Roberta Tassani for information.

FIRST RECONCILIATION/FIRST EUCHARIST - Children are prepared for these sacraments after completing a year of remote preparation in either the school or a religious education program. This is a two-year program; the first year is a general introduction, and the second year being specific preparation. Parents attend preparation sessions for each sacrament. Contact Mary Hupf, Director for Elementary Faith Formation, for more information.

BECOMING CATHOLIC - Adults who wish to join the Catholic Faith participate in sessions of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.) Contact the Parish Office for further information or email becomingCatholic@holyrosaryedmonds.org.
