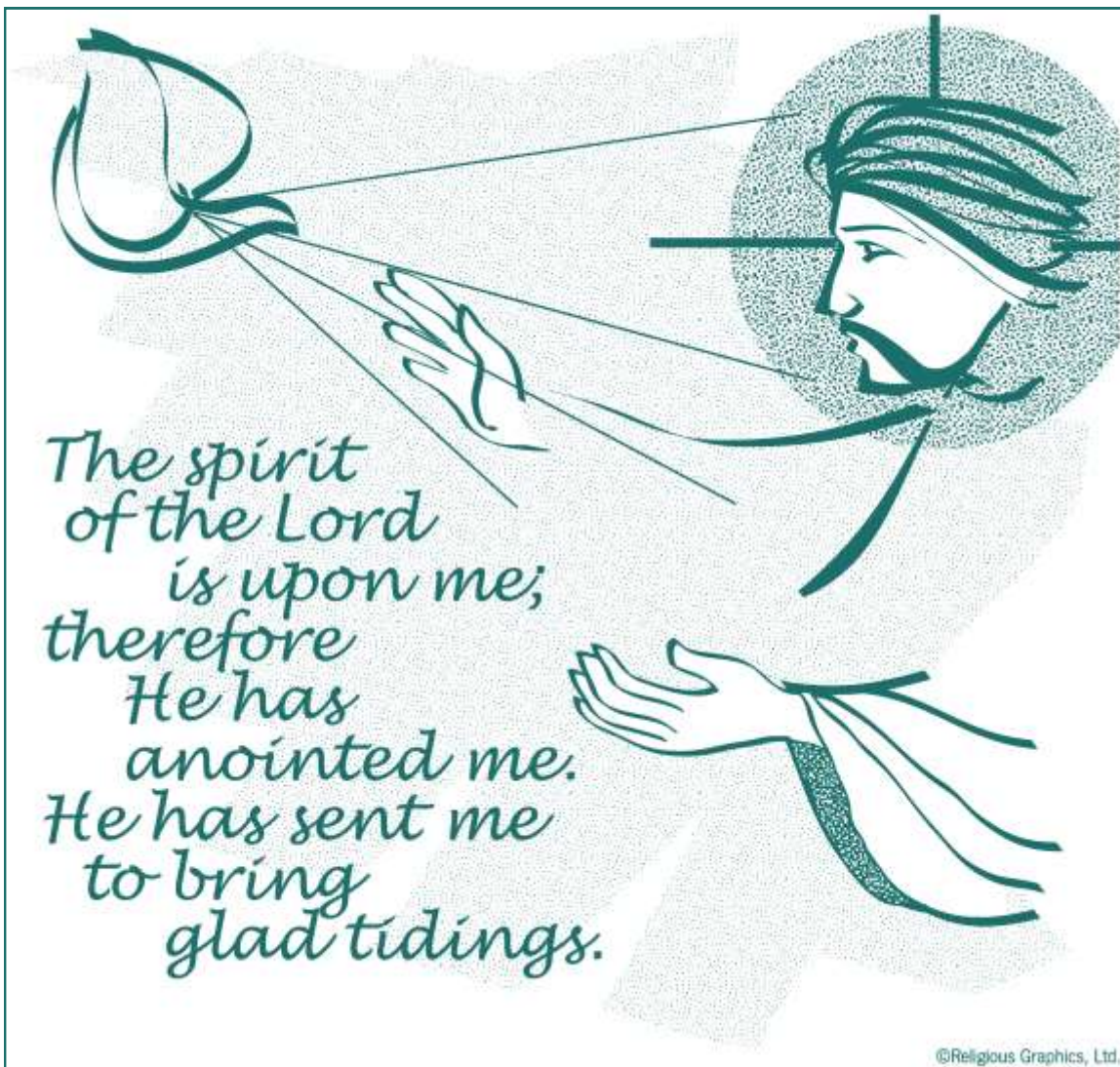

Dear Parishioners,

This week we are celebrating Catholic Schools week. It is a time when we acknowledge and celebrate our Catholic schools and in particular our own school of Holy Rosary. We are blessed as a parish to have this school as a ministry of our parish. A school adds a dimension of vitality and opportunity to share our Catholic faith with young people and families. Our challenge is always to find ways to engage our school families more in the life of the parish, which is something the school and the parish are working on. A committee also continues to work on the Catholic identity of our school and many of these initiatives have started this school year, including having school Masses on Fridays.

In a time when Catholic education across the country is experiencing a decline and Catholic schools are closing due to the rising cost of education and lower enrollment, we are pleased that our own school has experienced growth over the past five years and we are at near capacity. We can attribute this to the excellent leadership we have with our Principal Sue Venable coupled with a strong, dedicated and capable teaching and support staff. As you may realize it becomes more difficult to fund a private school and to remain competitive with our teacher salaries. We continue to making every effort to ensure our salaries are competitive. Each year the parish offers a subsidy to help financially support the school.

The effort and resources our parish puts into our school is worth it because it educates children in a Catholic context and catechizes children in the Faith who may not otherwise be exposed. Our mission as Catholics is to evangelize, that is, to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the teachings of the Church. Our school provides a perfect opportunity to evangelize the children and families who attend our school. We will continue to strive to offer an excellent academic program with a strong Catholic identity.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

INFANT BAPTISM - Parents and godparents attend one session to prepare to celebrate this sacrament. We encourage parents to attend before the birth or adoption of their child. Please call the Parish Office at least six weeks prior to the desired Baptism date to register your child. Next preparation class is on March 3rd, 2019, beginning with Mass at 11AM and ending by 2:30PM. Please call the Parish Office to register. Next scheduled baptisms are on February 10th and March 17th. Baptisms are scheduled with Father Vincent on the *second Sunday of the month, after the 11AM Mass*. Parishioners who prefer to have the Baptism at “their” regular mass time may make that request through the parish office.

MARRIAGE - Couples wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the parish at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Preparation for celebrating and living the sacrament is required. Catholics are to be confirmed prior to celebrating marriage. Contact Roberta Tassani for more information.

ANONTING OF THE SICK - is celebrated any time there is a serious illness or health crisis. Contact the parish office to make arrangements.

FUNERALS - Please contact the parish after a death, and *before* making arrangements with a funeral home.

CONFIRMATION - The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated yearly for those who are age 16 or older. Attendance at preparation sessions is required. Contact the Parish office or email kellyg@holyrosaryedmonds.org for information.

Adults who have not been confirmed may also celebrate the sacrament, which is a requirement for the Sacrament of Marriage and a prerequisite to be a godparent. Contact Roberta Tassani for information.

FIRST RECONCILIATION/FIRST EUCHARIST - Children are prepared for these sacraments over the course of two years during which the child participates in a grade-level faith formation program in the school or parish, or through a homeschool curriculum provided by the parish. In the second year, at least one parent and their child of at least seven years of age attend six sacramental preparation workshops together. BECOMING CATHOLIC - Adults who wish to join the Catholic Faith participate in sessions of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.) Contact the Parish Office for further information or email becomingCatholic@holyrosaryedmonds.org.
