Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday, the Baptism of the Lord, will close the Christmas Season and we will begin Ordinary Time. It has been a season of grace for our parish to once again celebrate Advent and Christmas, the Incarnation. I hope that all of us have grown in our love and understanding of Our Lord, as did Our Lady, who kept and pondered the events of Jesus' life in her heart. Like the liturgy, the Rosary keeps us reflecting and pondering on the Mysteries of Christ.

We were delighted as a parish on Jan. 1st to dedicate and bless our new statue of Mary as Our Lady of the Rosary. She is giving the Rosary to us that is connected to Jesus. This shows that the Rosary takes us closer to Jesus. This statue is in a prominent place in our church and will forever be a reminder that Mary is always close to us as mother. As she holds her son Jesus she is always connecting us to the Mysteries we celebrate. She always looks upon her children with compassion and love. Once again I thank all those who had a hand in making this beautiful statue a reality for our parish. It will be enjoyed for generations to come.

Some years ago the Bishops of the United States of America designated January 22nd as a day to be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life. It is a day of penance for the violation to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion. Please join us that day for Mass at 5:30PM as we pray as a community for a greater respect for life, and the end of abortion. Also a bus will be going from our parish on the morning of Jan. 22nd for the Mass and March for Life in Olympia. If you may be interested in coming you can sign up after mass or call the office.

In response to the sexual abuse crisis in the Church we have been praying the prayer of St. Michael after communion at Mass for reparation, healing and purification of the Church. In addition, on Jan. 25th we will have a Holy Hour of Reparation. Reparation is to atone for our disobedience and sin, the evil that has been done. This Holy Hour will start at 7PM in the Church. It will be an opportunity to come together as a community to acknowledge this terrible wound to the body of Christ; to pray for healing for those who have been affected, and commit ourselves to be faithful to Christ and the teachings of his Church.

And finally, on Jan. 31st I will be presenting a slide show of my most recent walking pilgrimage in Italy. The slide show will begin at 7PM in the Pastoral Center. Five others and I walked from south of Florence to Assisi on the Way of St. Francis, an eleven day journey, over 160 miles. We passed through some very beautiful Italian countryside and visited holy sites connected with St. Francis. Come and share this wonderful journey.



## SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

**INFANT BAPTISM** - Parents and godparents attend one session to prepare to celebrate this sacrament. We encourage parents to attend before the birth or adoption of their child. Please call the Parish Office at least six weeks prior to the desired Baptism date to register your child. Next preparation classes are on January 20th, or March 3rd, 2019, beginning with Mass at 11AM and ending by 2:30PM. Please call the Parish Office to register. Next scheduled baptisms are on February 10th, 2019. Baptisms are scheduled with Father Vincent on the *second Sunday of the month, after the 11AM Mass*. Parishioners who prefer to have the Baptism at “their” regular mass time may make that request through the parish office.

**MARRIAGE** - Couples wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the parish at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Preparation for celebrating and living the sacrament is required. Catholics are to be confirmed prior to celebrating marriage. Contact Roberta Tassani for more information.

**ANONING OF THE SICK** - is celebrated any time there is a serious illness or health crisis. Contact the parish office to make arrangements.

**FUNERALS** - Please contact the parish after a death, and *before* making arrangements with a funeral home.

**CONFIRMATION** - The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated yearly for those who are age 16 or older. Attendance at preparation sessions is required. Contact the Parish office or email [kellyg@holyrosaryedmonds.org](mailto:kellyg@holyrosaryedmonds.org) for information.

Adults who have not been confirmed may also celebrate the sacrament, which is a requirement for the Sacrament of Marriage and a prerequisite to be a godparent. Contact Roberta Tassani for information.

**FIRST RECONCILIATION/FIRST EUCHARIST** - Children are prepared for these sacraments over the course of two years during which the child participates in a grade-level faith formation program in the school or parish, or through a homeschool curriculum provided by the parish. In the second year, at least one parent and their child of at least seven years of age attend six sacramental preparation workshops together.
