Maintenance: Continuing regular maintenance. New roof and foundation work completed on St. Martin Center and roof on Parish Hall. Roofers to return to re-connect lightning arrestors on SMC. Grade School chimney has been repaired, waiting on chimney caps. Plans are in place for repainting of cafeteria, removal of curtains and placement of decorative film over windows to be done after gymnasium repairs are made. Cafeteria work will be paid for from Bereavement Fund. In the church, foundation vents have been replaced and the steeple repaired to prevent any further leaking. A dehumidifier will be placed in the loft. A parishioner offered to pay for an automatic door opener at the ramp entrance. Deacon Joe arranged to have a door donated, Terry Roberts provided the electrical work necessary and the door will be installed this week. Patrick Hobbs made several repairs to the grounds around the church, the playground and the rear of the cemetery, evidenced by the areas of straw. The gym repairs continue, with Medleys to install downspouts and Phillip Bros to repair foundation. While Phillip Bros is on site, the Picnic committee has agreed to pay for a walkway from the gym to the Parish Hall garage area. The gym stage curtain arrived and has been hung, but was found to be too short for the stage. Extensions have been ordered and will be installed upon arrival. Rectory foundation repairs are completed, included replacement of 2 basement windows. Repairs still needed in one bedroom and on stair railing. Parish Hall is still awaiting an overall plan for repair/remodel. Plans are to put landscaping rock around SMC and Parish Hall.

<u>Cemetery:</u> The large tree in the front corner must be removed due to rot. Several more trees will be planted throughout the cemetery.

<u>Playground:</u> Dirt work has been done around the playground. Swing mats are in place and benches and picnic tables are planned for the spring. For any donations of picnic tables, contact Brandi Lusk.

<u>Archives:</u> Repairs are generally completed, carpet and wall bases down and items being moved back into place now. The Altar and Communion rails still need attention and will not be moved into place until a later date. The repairs were more expensive than planned and the Archives account is currently in a negative balance. Planning for a fundraiser scheduled for Nov. 3 featuring The Monarchs continues, with sponsor donations covering the cost of the band.

Mark made a motion: Parish Hall and cafeteria to be rented by parishioners for insurance coverage only (mandated by Archdiocesan policy) + damage/key deposit. Todd seconded motion. All approved. New policy will be Parish Hall and Cafeteria rented for insurance fee (\$95) + damage/key deposit (\$100), totaling \$195. Gymnasium rented for rental (\$350 includes insurance fee) + damage/key deposit (\$300) totaling \$650.

Brandi asked for and received permission to have Trunk or Treat on parish grounds Oct 31 from 5p.m. to 8 p.m.

Reminder that this is the last meeting for Sandy and Amy as Parish Council members. New members are to be appointed in November. Sandy and Amy were asked to attend the December meeting.
