### VASCULAR AND ABDOMINAL ULTRASOUND SCREENINGS

Rightway Imaging will be screening **Carotid Arteries** on both sides of the neck checking for fatty plaque build-up and blockage which is the number one cause of stroke! The **Thyroid** for cysts, masses and unusual growth *which is very common among women*. The **Lower Abdominal Aorta** for aneurysms *which can go unnoticed until time of rupture*. The **Liver, Spleen, Gallbladder**, and both **Right and Left Kidneys** for cysts, masses, unusual growth, kidney stones and gallstones, *which can also go unnoticed until pain begins and can be a good indicator of future issues of the body*. 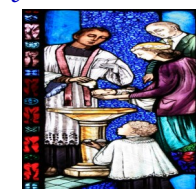
