TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME HOUSEHOLDS IN GOD'S SERVICE

In the ancient world, "household" was a wide-reaching concept. When Joshua today speaks of his household serving the Lord, he meant not just those people who lived inside his walls or those related to him by blood or marriage; he meant slaves or servants and their families, and anyone indebted to him in any way. Even his livestock and other possessions would be consecrated to service of God. In our world, we value allowing individuals their freedom to choose how they live, and wouldn't think of offering our pets to the service of God. But, as we discern our vocation as disciples baptized into Christ, we can come to realize how far-ranging the "households" of our lives still are: how we act toward our spouses, children, roommates or anyone we live with; our behavior with neighbors; or in public as we encounter many "strangers" every day in stores or traffic who suddenly are "next door" to us. How can we use our time, our resources, or gifts for selfless reasons rather than personal gain? No matter what life our witness to the Good News calls us to, we all have a "household" that must be consecrated to service of the Lord our God.

Lord, Teach Me To Pray (LTMTPray) is a prayer series based on Ignatian Spirituality.

Part I, for women, begins on September 13, 2018, in Vincent Hall at 9:00am.

Part I, "Praying Christian Virtues", helps deepen prayer life, and discover what to do for obstacles in prayer. It also introduces the different methods of Ignatian prayer, meditation, contemplation and Consciousness Examen. A small group will meet with 2 trained facilitators for 1-2 hours once a week for 12 weeks to pray and faith share.

Part II, for women, begins on September 13, 2018, in Vincent Hall at 6:30pm.

Part II, "My 19th Annotation", consists of the entirety of the well-known "Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius". A small group will meet with 2 trained facilitators for 1-2 hours once a week for 30 weeks with a one month break.

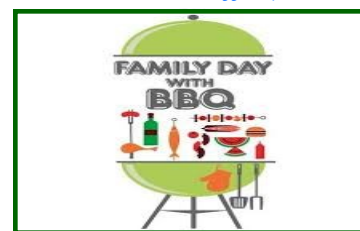

Our Lady of the Rosary's Parish School of Religion offers religious education classes for young people in 1st through 11th grades who do not attend Catholic school. These classes will help our young people to grow in the love, knowledge, and service of God and His Church. Parish School of Religion will also prepare our young people to receive First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in 2nd grade.

2018-2019 School Year Information:
Parish School of Religion classes will be held on Wednesday evenings from 5:00-6:00pm from September 26 through May 15. Classes will meet in Vincent Hall, 1324 Moss Street.

There will be no classes on the following Wednesdays: November 21, December 26, January 2, March 6, and April 24.

First Reconciliation will be celebrated on Saturday, December 15 at 10am.

First Holy Communion will be celebrated on Sunday, May 19, at 11am Mass.

A registration form can be found on the parish website or on the credenzas in church. Please return the form to the parish office with a copy of your child's Baptismal certificate and the registration fees: 1 Child: \$30.00; 2 or more children \$25.00 per child.

Confirmation Preparation

Our Lady of the Rosary's Confirmation Program will provide sacramental preparation for juniors in high school who wish to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. This sacramental preparation is required for all juniors, regardless of whether they attend Catholic school, public school, private school, or home school. **Note:** For any juniors who do not attend Catholic schools, enrollment in our Parish School of Religion is also required.

Confirmation preparation seminars will be held on Sunday afternoons 4:00pm-5:45pm in Vincent Hall, on the following Sundays: September 23, October 28, November 25, December 16, January 27, and February 17.

March 16 and 17 will be a Confirmation retreat with St. Pius X at Camp Abbey near Covington. There will be a group service project on Saturday, April 13, in the morning and early afternoon.

The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated on Saturday, May 11, at 4pm Mass by Bishop Fernand J. Cheri.
