- No chewing gum
- **No alcohol allowed on the grounds at all and especially not inside the church**
- Flower Girls are not allowed to drop flower petals
- No glass candles are allowed in the aisles of the church
- No FLASH photography during ceremony / videography ---- (discuss with Wedding Coordinators)
- If the bride has a Rolls Royce, she will wait in the stairwell if it is warm outside. With cooler weather the bride remains in the Rolls Royce.
- There is one restroom so please be sure that everyone uses the restroom before they get to the church because when they arrive there is already a line for the restrooms.

Wedding Coordinators request the Groom and Groomsmen to arrive at the church about one hour before the wedding. The Bride and Bridesmaids are expected 30 minutes before the wedding ceremony. The Wedding Coordinators arrive about 1-1/2 hours before the wedding. Check with your florist for their arrival time. Weddings without a Full Mass are approximately 45 to 60 minutes in length. Weddings with a Full Mass are approximately 1 hour and 10 minutes.
