I would like to thank the Bishop of Hamilton and my own Bishop in Madras for giving me this golden opportunity to enrich myself with this great three years' of mission in Kitchener. I would like to apologize very sincerely if I have hurt anyone in these years by my words and actions. I thank God for his graciousness to me.

I am taking over a small parish, Sacred Heart Garrison Church at HVF Avadi, Chennai (was called Madras) and I will also be teaching in the major seminary which is 13 kms away. This is my assignment for now. My parents and siblings live 21 kms from my parish. So I can visit them more often.
