**Epiphany, the Feast of The Three Kings**



Epiphany is celebrated 12 days after Christmas on the 6<sup>th</sup> of January and is the time when Christians remember the Wise Men (also called the Three Kings) who visited Jesus.

Epiphany means 'revelation' and both the visit of the Wise Men and his Baptism are important times when Jesus was 'revealed' to be very important.
