- The Bishop's Charity and Stewardship Appeal (CSA) begins this weekend and will continue through the end of May. Pledges are due to the Diocese by the end of June. The goal for St. Mary's Parish is \$6,220.00 and the goal for St. Helena's Parish is \$1,640.00. According to Tracy Lockwood, chief financial officer of the Diocese, the formula for CSA goals is proportional to 5-year average of Sunday and holy day collections plus CSA rebates for each parish. All pledges collected over the parish goal are returned to the parish as rebates. Those wishing to wait until Harvest to offer a non-traditional gift are asked to speak to Fr. Zimmer directly.
