Dear Families of Confirmation Candidates,

Enclosed you will find the permission form for the retreat to St. Clement's Island, set for **Saturday, April 13th, 2019** rain date **Saturday, April 27th, 2019**. I will need the fee and permission slip returned to me by Sunday, April 7th, 2019. The fee for this year's trip is \$50.00. I also need about 2 or 3 adults to accompany us as chaperones.
