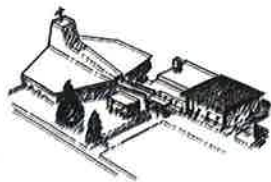

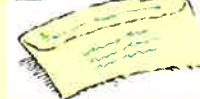


Request from Society of St. Vincent de Paul ~
