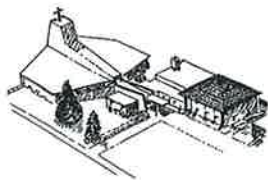

–to establish a liturgical committee that will involve all ministries and others

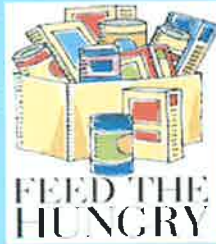
–teaching moment on liturgical practices
