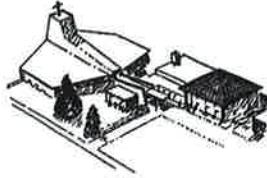

We, the faith community of St. John Vianney Church, celebrating the Eucharist as the centre of our faith, are committed to living out the Word of God in our homes, schools and community.



With great joy in my heart I announce to you: "Christ is risen! He is risen, indeed"! This ancient greeting sums up what we celebrate this Easter Sunday, the joy of Christ risen and alive in our midst.

In John's Gospel, Mary Magdalene goes to the tomb early in the morning while it is still dark. She discovers that the stone has been rolled back and nothing but an empty tomb is to be found. At first, she believes someone has taken the body of Jesus. Her doubts, sadness and loss are intensified. It would take an encounter with the Risen Lord for her grief to become hope. This encounter transforms her life, the lives of the early disciples and ours, too. Their darkness and our darkness give way to glory, light and new life. Easter enables us to believe with great joy that He has risen. The empty tomb and our empty lives become full with this new life. Christ is risen! The Resurrection of Jesus is at the centre of our faith. St. Paul, in his First Letter to the Corinthians states: "If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain, and your faith is in vain." (Cor. 15:14) Christ is risen and we, too, share in the gift of eternal life. When we live the new life of the resurrection, we become the best version our ourselves. We become an "Easter People", a people transformed into disciples and stewards to commit to give their time, talent and treasure in witness.

I pray that you and your family enjoy this Easter Day. I plan to put my limited culinary skills to work again this Easter as I prepare an Easter feast for my family, my prayer for you this Easter is that you live as people deeply touched by the resurrection and proclaim: "Christ is risen. Alleluia! Alleluia!
