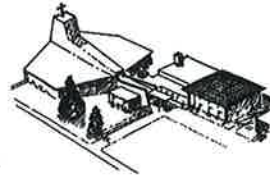

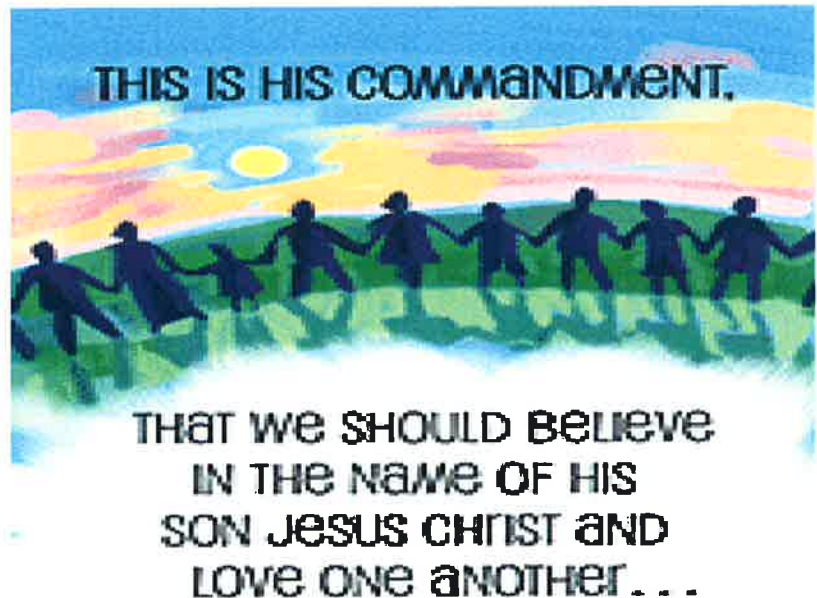

Dear Friends,

We honoured our Mothers, reflected on the meaning of God's personal call, prayed for vocations, and we prayed with our young people as they received Jesus in the Eucharist for the first time.
