

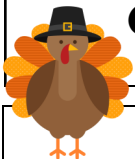

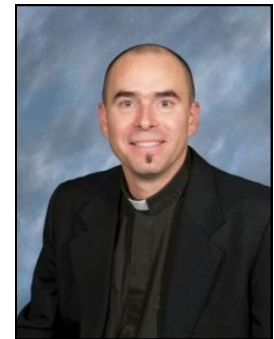
### THANKSGIVING DAY
