

ASH WEDNESDAY AND LENT

The annual Lenten Season beginning this Wednesday which is called ASH WEDNESDAY, because of the traditional imposition of blessed ashes on the foreheads of the Faithful is the fitting time to climb the holy mountain of Easter. The Lenten Season has a double character, mainly to prepare both Catechumens and faithful & celebrate the Paschal mystery. The Catechumens, both with the Rite of Election and Scrutinies and by catechesis are prepared for the celebration of the sacraments of initiation. The Faithful, ever more attentive to the Word of God and prayer, prepare themselves by penance for the renewal of their baptismal promises at Easter. Lent runs from Ash Wednesday, March 6th to the Mass of the Last Supper on Holy Thursday, this year on April 18th. Look on it as a great God-given opportunity to draw closer to the Lord.
