Our camp cost \$75.00 a week or \$20.00 a day. \$145 for two children, \$210 for three children.

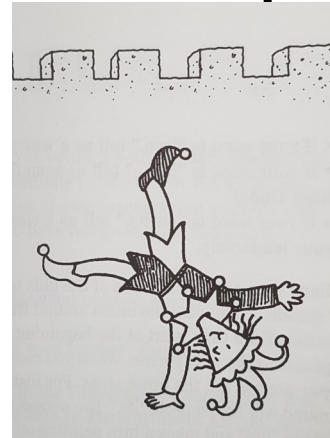
At the trumpet call come & meet our SERFS, Lady Leggomutton and
