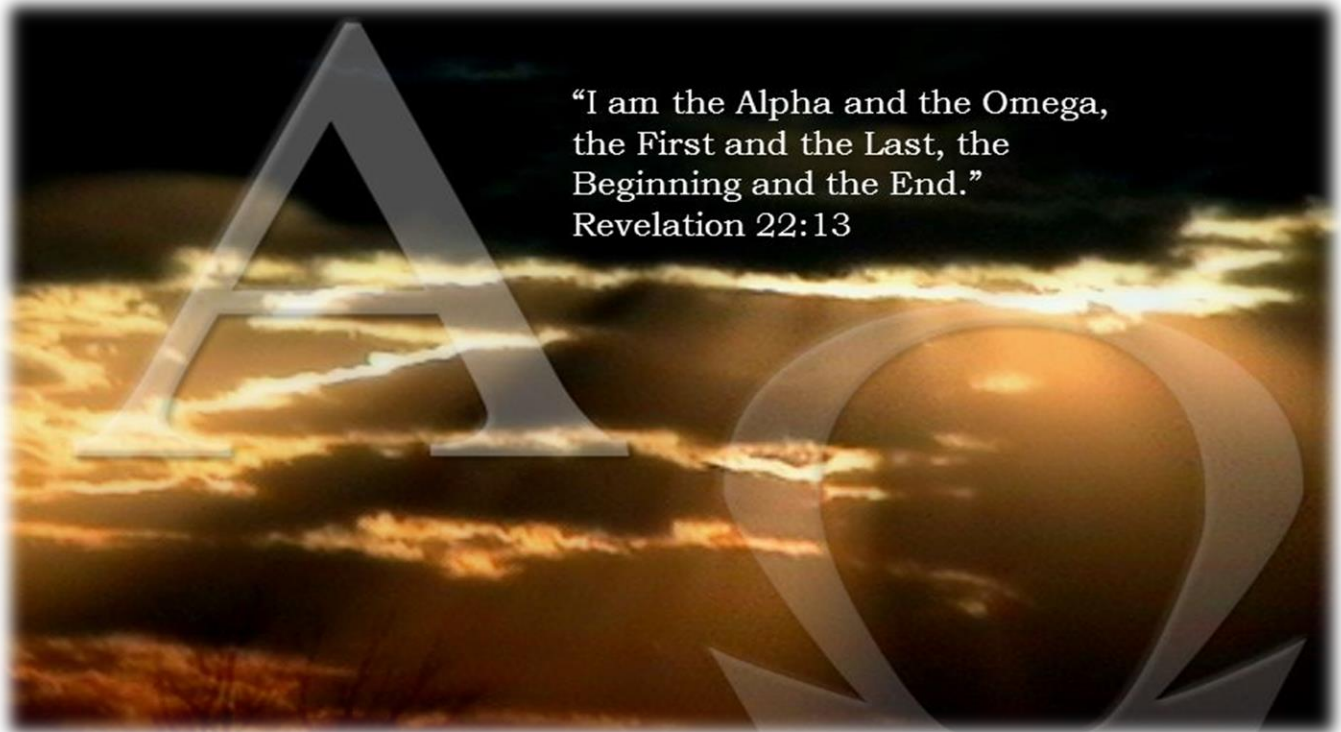

It is always a source of common gratification when parishioners and benefactors come together to pray, celebrate, and rejoice for all the blessings that the Lord so abundantly showers upon us out of His goodness and unmatched generosity. As most of you know, two successful events took place in our parish last weekend. An organ recital was performed on the evening of Friday, May 24th to officially inaugurate our new pipe organ and the blessing of two beautiful hand-carved wooden statues, one of Saint Francis embraced by the Crucified Lord and the other of Saint Clare, the first female disciple of Saint Francis of Assisi and the foundress of the Poor Clares. Maestro David Reccia Chynoweth, a well-known Australian organist who resides in Italy, performed an exciting concert for the attendees that demonstrated the power and beauty of the sounds that emit from this wonderful instrument. The organ was donated to our Church by our friends and benefactors Carol and Nick Ferreri from Fort Myers, FL.

On Sunday, May 26th, His Eminence Cardinal Sean O'Malley celebrated the 12 Noon Mass where he dedicated the organ to the glory of God and blessed the two new statues. Father Claude, Father Jack Izzo, SJ, and I were the concelebrants while Father Robert Kickham, the Cardinal's secretary, was the Master of Ceremonies. Cardinal Sean was visibly enthusiastic about both the organ and the statues and personally thanked their donors. Both statues were donated to our Church by my good friend Amy Aceto-Hitchinson, from Chicago. She has been generously supporting us throughout the whole process of our church restoration.

My heartfelt thanks and congratulations go to Saint Joseph's Society that so beautifully restored our Church Hall, which the Cardinal blessed at the end of the Mass. They also organized a fine reception to which all those present were invited. I would also like to acknowledge the contributions of Montilio's Bakery, Frank DePasquale, Modern Pastry, Mike's Pastry, Bova's Bakery and Parziale's Bakery who donated pastry, cookies, and other goodies. To them also, I wish to say thank you.

As you are in Church, please take a close look at the statue of Saint Francis. I am sure that you will appreciate the intensity of the gaze of Francis for Christ and of Christ for Francis. The statue powerfully declares the message of Christ's love for Francis and the love of Francis for Christ; this love became the ultimate goal of Francis' life from the day of his conversion until his final breath. May we be caught up in this love that alone has the power to change the course of our lives as it did with Francis and Clare.

12 PROMISES OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS TO ST. MARGARET MARY

- I will give them all the graces necessary for their state in life.
- I will establish peace in their families.
- I will comfort them in their trials.
- I will be their secure refuge during life, and, above all, in death.
- I will shed abundant blessings on all their undertakings
- Sinners will find in My Heart an infinite ocean of mercy.
- Lukewarm souls will become fervent.
- Fervent souls will rapidly grow in holiness and perfection.
- I will bless every place where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored.
- I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- The names of those who promote this devotion will be written in My Heart, never to be blotted out.
- I promise you, in the excessive mercy of My Heart, that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months, the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving their Sacraments; My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.



Act of Consecration to the Sacred Heart

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, to Thee I consecrate and offer up my person and my life, my actions, trials, and sufferings, that my entire being may henceforth only be employed in loving, honoring and glorifying Thee. This is my irrevocable will, to belong entirely to Thee, and to do all for Thy love, renouncing with my whole heart all that can displease Thee.

I take Thee, O Sacred Heart, for the sole object of my love, the protection of my life, the pledge of my salvation, the remedy of my frailty and inconstancy, the reparation for all the defects of my life, and my secure refuge at the hour of my death. Be Thou, O Most Merciful Heart, my justification before God Thy Father, and screen me from His anger which I have so justly merited. I fear all from my own weakness and malice, but placing my entire confidence in Thee, O Heart of Love, I hope all from Thine infinite Goodness. Annihilate in me all that can displease or resist Thee. Imprint Thy pure love so deeply in my heart that I may never forget Thee or be separated from Thee.

I beseech Thee, through Thine infinite Goodness, grant that my name be engraved upon Thy Heart, for in this I place all my happiness and all my glory, to live and to die as one of Thy devoted servants.
