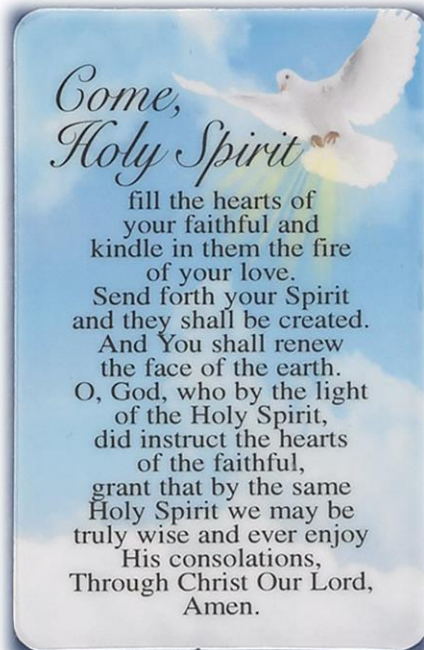

**Notice to Parishioners
from Father Antonio**

As you might already know, a month ago the City of Boston notified the Archdiocese that the fire escapes at Sacred Heart Church were overdue for inspection. The parish, with the help of the Archdiocese, retained the services of a structural engineer and it was found that the emergency fire exits from the Church are inadequate. Some of the exits end up in a small courtyard that is enclosed with buildings and therefore, in case of fire or other emergencies, lives would be threatened.

A meeting took place on Friday, May 31st between the property manager and engineer from the Archdiocese, an architect, a parishioner and myself. Under the advice of the Risk Management Department of the Archdiocese of Boston, we have been told to suspend any activities whatsoever at Sacred Heart Church until proper corrections to the fire exits has been implemented.

We have immediately perused advice from and retained an architect to come up with possible solutions to correct the deficiencies with the emergency exits at Sacred Heart Church.

As I believe in open communication with the community and parishioners, I pledge to bring all information to you immediately upon receiving it.

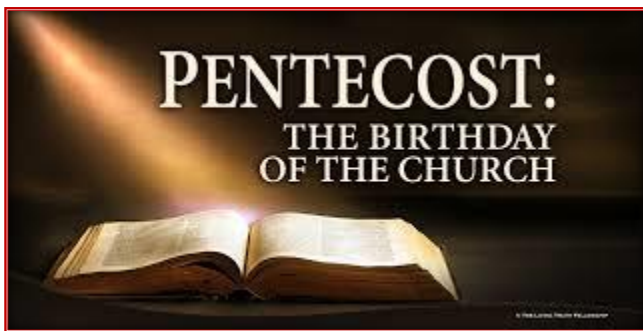

The feast of Pentecost is often referred to as the birthday of the Church. Our reading from the Acts of the Apostles tells of the Holy Spirit descending upon the Apostles. With the grace of the Holy Spirit, they were able to proclaim "the mighty acts of God" so that all may understand. This proclamation began the work of the Church on earth, the Church established by Christ and guided by the Holy Spirit

We are called to be united as **one**, professing one Lord, one faith, and one Baptism.

We, as members of the Church, are called to be **holy** through the sanctifying grace poured out to us, through the Holy Spirit.

Our Great Commission is to "go make disciples of all nations." The word **catholic** means universal – welcoming all people to the fullness of charity found in the Church.

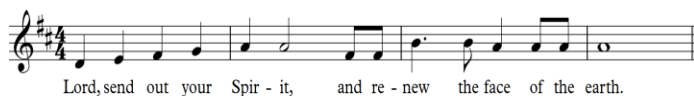
