Notice to Parishioners
from Father Antonio

As you might already know, a month ago the City of Boston notified the Archdiocese that the fire escapes at Sacred Heart Church were overdue for inspection. The parish, with the help of the Archdiocese, retained the services of a structural engineer and it was found that the emergency fire exits from the Church are inadequate. Some of the exits end up in a small courtyard that is enclosed with buildings and therefore, in case of fire or other emergencies, lives would be threatened.

A meeting took place on Friday, May 31st between the property manager and engineer from the Archdiocese, an architect, a parishioner and myself. Under the advice of the Risk Management Department of the Archdiocese of Boston, we have been told to suspend any activities whatsoever at Sacred Heart Church until proper corrections to the fire exits has been implemented.

We have immediately perused advice from and retained an architect to come up with possible solutions to correct the deficiencies with the emergency exits at Sacred Heart Church.

As I believe in open communication with the community and parishioners, I pledge to bring all information to you immediately upon receiving it.

The central doctrine of the Christian faith is the mystery of the Trinity.



The meaning of Most Holy Trinity is three Divine Persons in one God: God the Father, the creator of all; God the Son, the Savior of the world; and God the Holy Spirit, the Sanctifier and Advocate. All Three Persons are distinct, yet united as fully God.

Many scholars and theologians throughout the years have studied and written on the doctrine of the Trinity. There is no way to explain this central doctrine. The Trinity is something

that is impossible for any human to fully comprehend, let alone explain. Despite all attempts, most famously Saint Patrick and the example of the shamrock, the Trinity remains shrouded in mystery, seen through the eyes of faith.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states “The whole Christian life is a communion with each of the Divine Persons without in any way separating them... we are called to be a dwelling for the Most Holy Trinity” (CCC 259, 260).

God the Father is Love. God the Son is Love. God the Holy Spirit is Love. Through the graces and blessings of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, let our lives reflect the unified love of the Blessed Trinity.

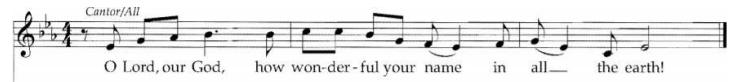

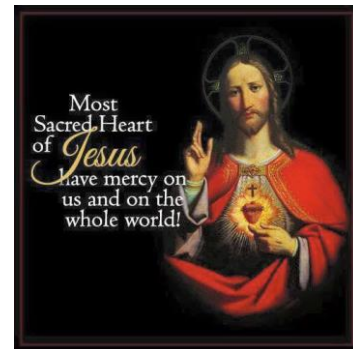
