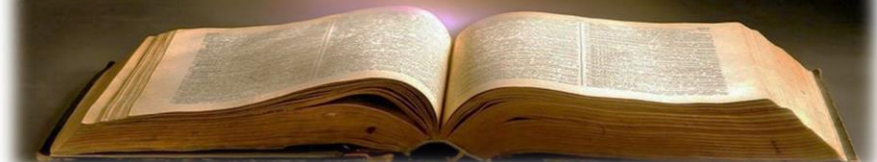

"Peace to this household"

Today's Gospel relates the story of Jesus commissioning 72 disciples to proclaim the Kingdom of God. They are instructed to not bring anything of worldly value with them, simply the Good News and the peace of Christ. Jesus warns the disciples their message of peace may be met with resistance, that they are like "lambs among the wolves". Whether welcomed or rejected, their instruction is clear: proclaim the Kingdom of God.

The same message is ours to proclaim to today's world. The peace of our Lord will bring transformation to us and to all we encounter. Where a culture of hatred and violence exists, we are called to preach a gospel of love and life. Much like the disciples, we often face opposition in a society that is focused on material gain and personal status. Still we are called to live as true Christian witnesses, preaching a Gospel of peace and exemplifying a life of Christian charity.

"All must be prepared to confess Christ before men. They must be prepared to make this profession of faith even in the midst of persecutions, which will never be lacking to the Church, in following the way of the cross."
