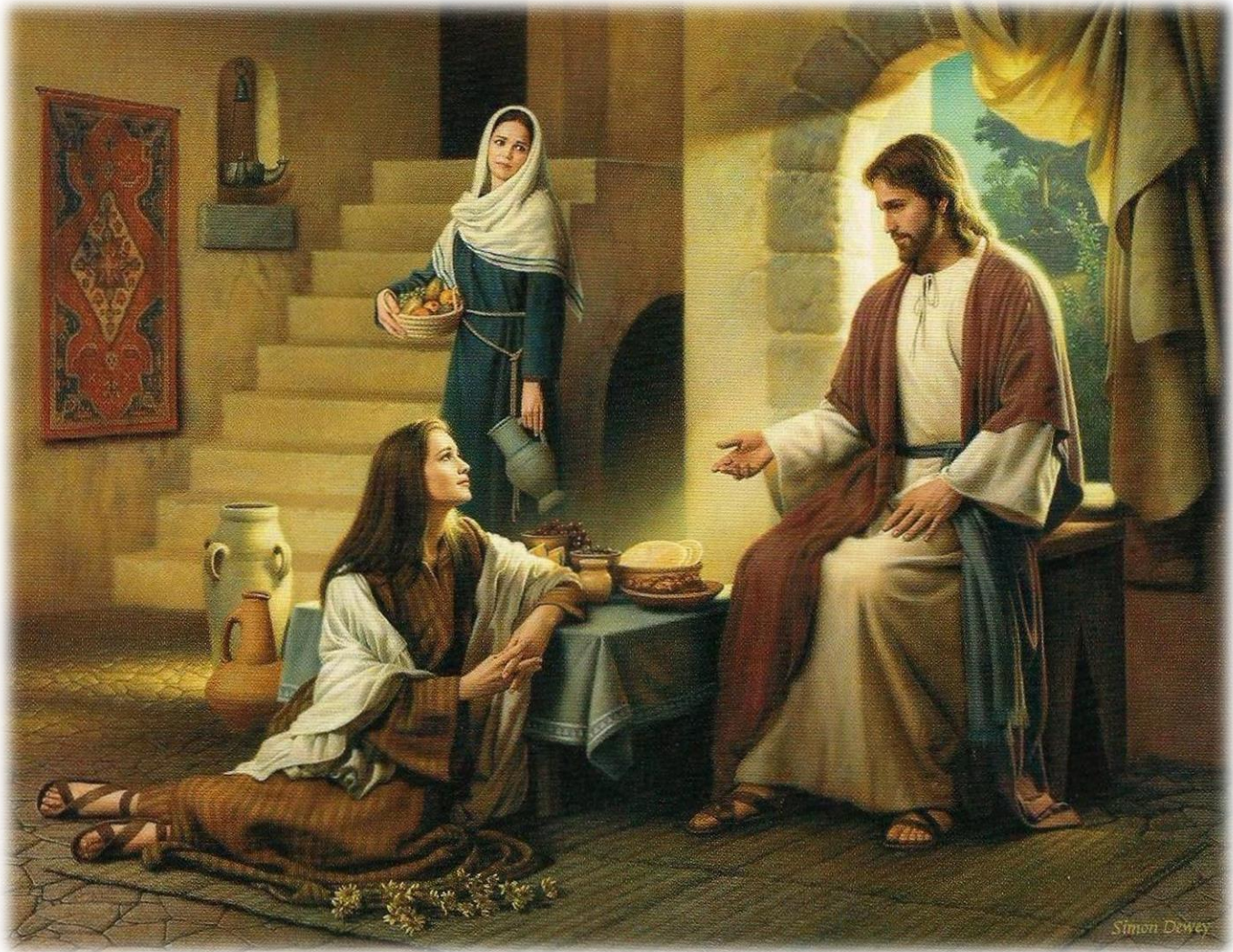

that He may let you enter there.

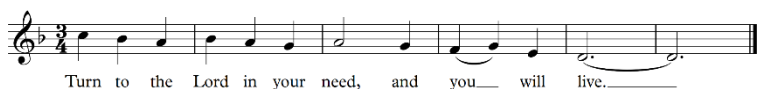

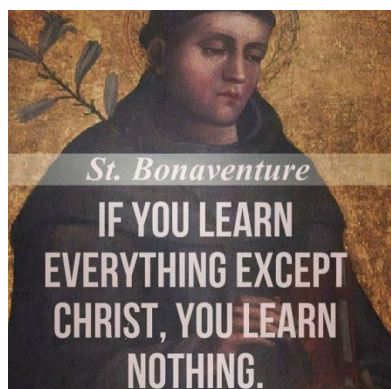

July 15th is the feast of Saint Bonaventure, one of the Order of Friars Minor's most notable members. Miraculously cured as an infant through the intercession of Saint Francis of Assisi, he joined the Franciscans, leading the fast-growing order for eighteen years as Minister General.

Known as the "Seraphic Doctor," Saint Bonaventure was honored with the title "Doctor of the Church," in recognition for his contributions to the understanding and interpretation of the sacred Scriptures and the development of Christian doctrine. In his writings, Saint Bonaventure emphasized the importance of mystical union with God, as was exemplified by the life of Saint Francis.



Saint Bonaventure is the Patron Saint of Franciscans studying theology. On this special feast, let us all remember in our prayers those in formation, that their minds and hearts may be enlightened with the fire of the Holy Spirit.

All-powerful Father,
through the intercession of St. Bonaventure,
we ask that you hear the intentions
we hold in our hearts.

May we always benefit from his wisdom
and follow the example of his love.
