

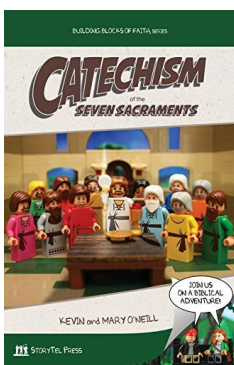
# A FAMILY OF *Faith* October Take Home Sheet

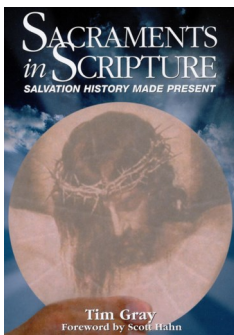
## October Recommended Resources
