### Welcome & Registration

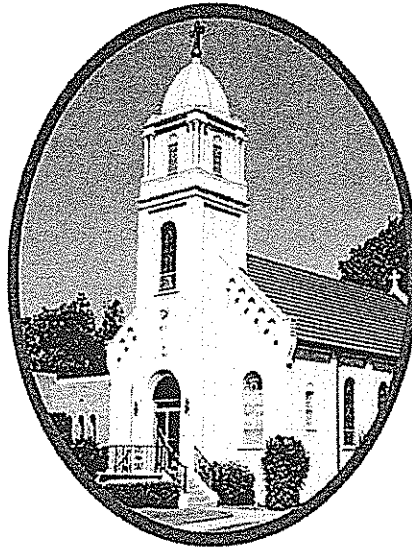
We welcome any visitors, including those who may not be of our Catholic faith. We pray that our celebration of the sacred liturgy today was a meaningful one for you.

### Sacraments

Eucharist - Sat Vigil: 5:00 p.m.; Sun: 8:00 a.m. & 10:45 a.m.; Daily Mass: M, W, Th, F at 12 noon; First Saturday ONLY is at 8:00 a.m.; (Holydays - See special announcement in bulletin)

Penance - Sat: 4:30-4:45 p.m.; Sun: 7:30-7:45 a.m. & 10:15-10:30 a.m. (and by appt.)

Baptism - A preparation class is required of the parents requesting Baptism for their first child. Parents and godparents are encouraged to attend the class before the baby's birth. (Scheduled as needed.)

Confirmation - Confirmation is celebrated in the spring with students who are at least in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade and have completed the requirements for the preparation process in our PRE program.

Matrimony - Couples planning to marry should contact the Pastor at least 5 months prior to the proposed date so all parish and diocesan requirements may be completed.

Holy Orders - If you feel called to a vocation in the priesthood or religious life, please contact the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick - If you wish to receive this sacrament, contact the pastor. If there is an emergency situation, an immediate family member should contact the pastor.

### 2018-2019 PRE Registration Information

1. The Discount Deadline for the 2018-2019 PRE Registration is 3:00 pm on July 5, 2018. Tuition on or before July 5, 2018 is \$25 for the first child, and \$5 for each remaining child in the family. Tuition after July 5, 2018 is \$30 for the first child, and \$10 for each remaining child in the family.
2. 2018-2019 PRE Registration Deadline is 3:00 pm on July 25, 2018. The only registrations that will be accepted after this deadline will be for newly registered families moving into the area.
3. Classes begin on Sunday, August 5, 2018. \*Note: All PRE classes are held on Sunday morning.
4. 2018-2019 PRE Registration Packets can be found on the shelves in the foyer under the bulletin board and on the website. A completed PRE registration form, a Medical Release Form and a Media Permission Form are required EACH year for EACH student registering for PRE. All three forms are included in the registration packet. \*\*Note: If your child has received a sacrament (Baptism, 1<sup>st</sup> Penance, 1<sup>st</sup> Communion, Confirmation) or has made a Profession of Faith in a Catholic Church other than Holy Angels, please attach a copy of the sacramental certificate to the registration packet.
5. 1<sup>st</sup> Penance/1<sup>st</sup> Communion Registration Packets will be handed out and discussed with the students and their parents at the **MANDATORY** Parent/Student Meeting on Sunday, August 19, 2018 at 9:30 a.m. in the parish hall
6. Confirmation Registration Packets and Service hour information will be handed out and discussed with the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades students and their parents at the **MANDATORY** Parent/Student Meeting on Sunday, August 26, 2018. The meetings will be held in the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade classrooms.
7. Also, keep in mind the diocesan requirement that students registering for a sacrament (1<sup>st</sup> Penance, 1<sup>st</sup> Communion, Confirmation) must have attended PRE here or somewhere else the prior year in order to register for the sacrament. These students must also provide a copy of the certificate for all sacraments already received.
8. Service Scholarship applications can be found on the PRE bulletin board in the PRE hall at the canopy entrance and on the website.
9. All PRE registrations packets and sacramental class registration packets are to be turned in to Mr. Pete Hinkel in the parish office. For your convenience, registration packets/tuition can be dropped off at the parish office, mailed to the parish office or dropped in either of the secure drop boxes provided. (1. On the wall next to the mailbox outside, or 2. On the wall next to Pete Hinkel's office.)

**May – Month of Our Lady**

“In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” Christians who use this phrase repeatedly could easily lose sight of the powerful mystery it expresses. Today, Trinity Sunday, the Scriptures call for reflection on this central belief of Christianity: the Trinity. One of the greatest gifts of the Christian faith is the dogma of the triune God: God is three (tri) in one (une). Christians name God as a Trinity of Father, Son, and Spirit, but only in light of Jesus Christ does such language and insight fully emerge.

**FIRST READING** (Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 3-40) Moses speaks to his people, reminding them of the wondrous uniqueness of their relationship with God. He takes them back to the dawn of creation and says that never has another people been favored by God as they have. Moses invites us to consider our own experience of God’s care.

**RESPONSORIAL PSALM** (33:4-5, 6, 9, 18-19, 20, 22) On this Sunday, contemplating the mystery of the Trinity, we remember that God never forgets us. As a parent takes delight in watching a child, so God watches over us, always ready to come near when we call.

**SECOND READING** (Romans 8:14-17) We end our Eucharistic Prayer remembering that all honor to God comes through, with, and in Christ. Our reading from Romans reminds us that Christ’s Spirit inhabits us, so that we are not only able to be led by the Spirit, but that the Spirit within us will draw us into deeper communion with God.

**GOSPEL** (Matthew 28:16-20) Matthew tells us that Jesus’ last interchange with the disciples included a promise and a mission. The two go together. The promise is that he is Emmanuel, God who will always be with us. The mission is to share that experience of God with the entire world. All of the baptized have a share of that mission. How are you called to fulfill it?

**THE ROMAN MISSAL** The Collect expresses for us the meaning of this solemnity not in terms of some dry theological doctrine but rather in terms of the active, dynamic power of the triune God: the Father sends into the world the Word of truth and the Spirit of sanctification and, in so doing, reveals to the human race his own “wondrous mystery.” The prayer affirms that through the Trinity we know the very life of God himself. The Prayer over the Offerings makes the important liturgical point that as we make the offering of our lives at this liturgy—“this oblation of our service”—its ultimate purpose is that by it we might be made “an eternal offering to you.” The prayer expresses how in the liturgy, we are swept up into the life of the Trinity so that our entire life might be lived with the same self-emptying, self-giving love that exists between the three divine Persons. The Prayer after Communion also gives voice to the basic statement about the Trinity nonetheless being “undivided Unity.”

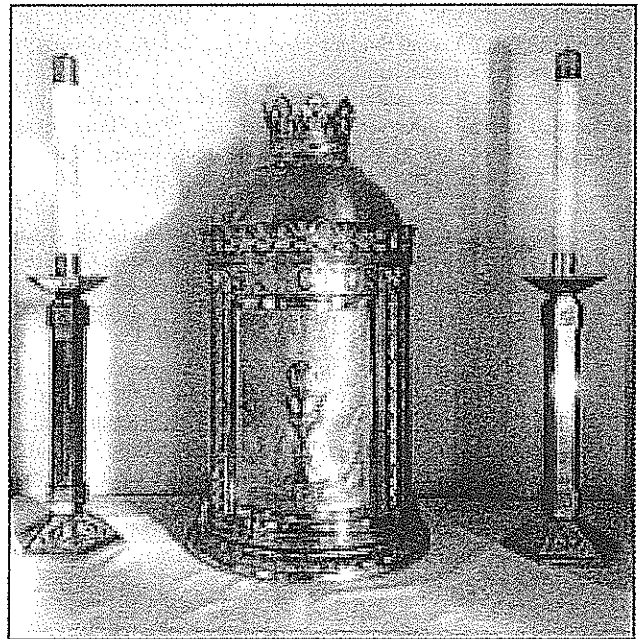

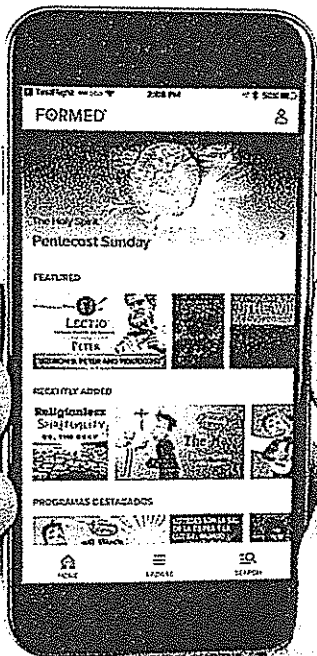
