FROM THE PASTORS DESK

O’ Sacrament Most Holy, O’ Sacrament Divine

Dear Brothers and Sisters of St. Anthony’s,

As I was saying last Sunday: “It’s great to be back in the Ordinary Time of the Church Calendar.” I love wearing the green vestments; it’s good for the Irish side of my character. We now enter this long stretch of time from now until November 30th where we will follow the Gospel of Luke (Chapters 9-23). St. Luke is a favorite of many; the scribe of the meekness of Christ he has been called. Luke always presents Jesus as reaching out to sinners and outcasts, those that society counts as “Lost Souls.” If you have had a hard time following the way of the Lord Jesus, as some of us do from time to time, you have a friend in this wonderful evangelist.

Luke, whose feast day we celebrate on October 18th, is a wonderful guide in regards to our instruction in the ways of Jesus. He is the author of one of the canonical Gospels and the force behind the “Acts of the Apostle” which captures in detail the events of the “Infant Church.” He was a native of Antioch in Syria and also a physician, as well as an early convert from paganism. He was a companion of my great friend St. Paul and accompanied Paul on his missionary journeys. He was jailed with Paul on two occasions. In his gospel, Luke places great emphasis on the merciful heart of Jesus which is open to all. Thanks to this evangelist we have the very touching “Infancy Narratives” in the first two chapters of his Gospel, which have inspired countless children as they look upon the Christ child’s Christmas crib. So, enjoy Luke as you move through your summertime adventures!!!

Secondly, I would like to encourage you to sign up for times before our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. The Chapel in the Convent/Retreat House has been designated for Eucharistic Adoration. Hopefully we will get to the 24/7 time for Adoration. I realize this could take some time to get us there, but we have decided that it would greatly benefit our parish and the North Beach/Chesapeake Beach communities as well as the surrounding areas of Owings, and Rose Haven to have such a beautiful practice. My desire is to have many religious vocations from the Beach area to fill our seminary and religious houses. While we miss the presence of the religious sisters who have been in this convent for many years, I think it is a worthy use of the house. Since my early days in the priesthood I have always tried to encourage our young people to follow the Lord by considering a “Religious Calling.”

We will be forming a way to sign up in the next week. For now, if you would like to spend some time with the Eucharistic Lord you can call the St. Anthony’s business office at 443-646-5721 and get a code to enter the chapel. You can access the convent chapel and the bathroom. Please be responsible and use common sense when you are spending time with the Lord. In the upcoming weeks we will put together some more practical guidelines for the good of all.

The Lord Jesus promised us that He would be with us until the end of time. Our Eucharistic chapel is making that promise a reality.
