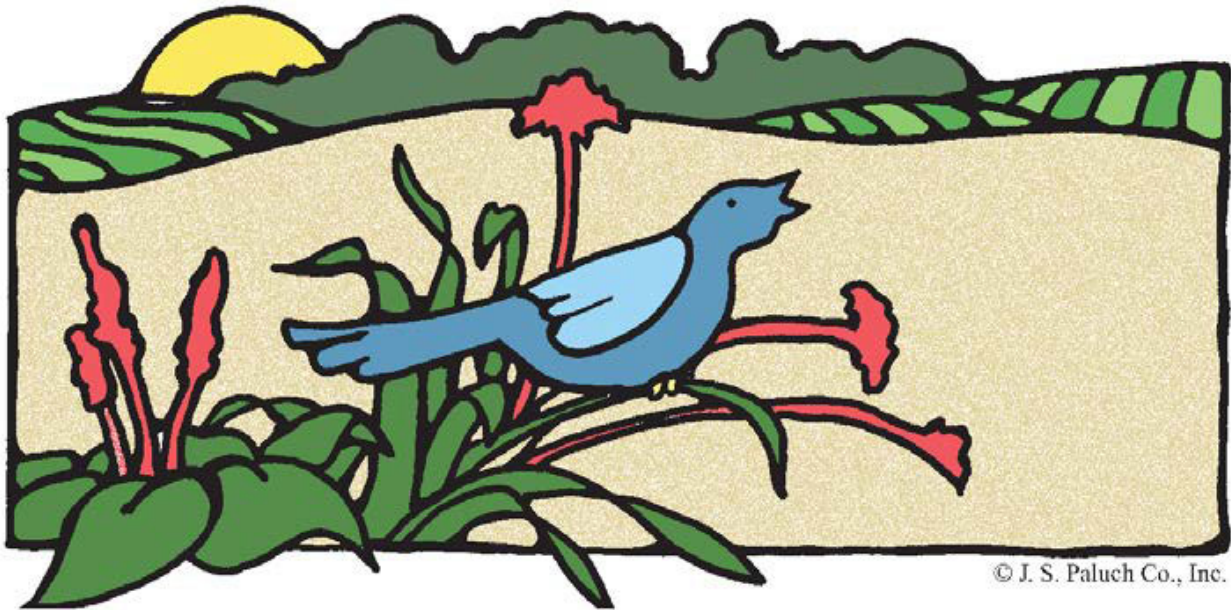

### Clergy Corner 9.8.19

My dear friends,

The Gospel selection for the 23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time once again challenges our notion of discipleship. The following quote is an insightful reflection from the “Opening the Word” series found on [www.FORMED.org](http://www.FORMED.org) (Augustine Institute):

*“What are you willing to give up to follow Jesus? That’s the question in today’s Gospel. Jesus proclaims that no one is worthy to be called His disciple unless he “hates” those people dearest to him, or renounces his possessions, takes up his cross and follows Jesus to wherever He leads (and if one is carrying a cross, then that led to only one place). We may try to qualify Jesus’ words, but they proclaim a great truth: there are no half-measures when following Jesus. He requires everything of us. Are we willing to say yes to that?”*

I encourage you to spend a few minutes today with the Gospel passage and this quote. It may lead you to the place where Jesus is calling you.

**RCIA is getting under way!**

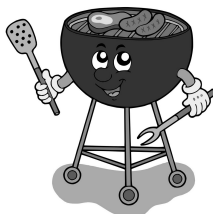

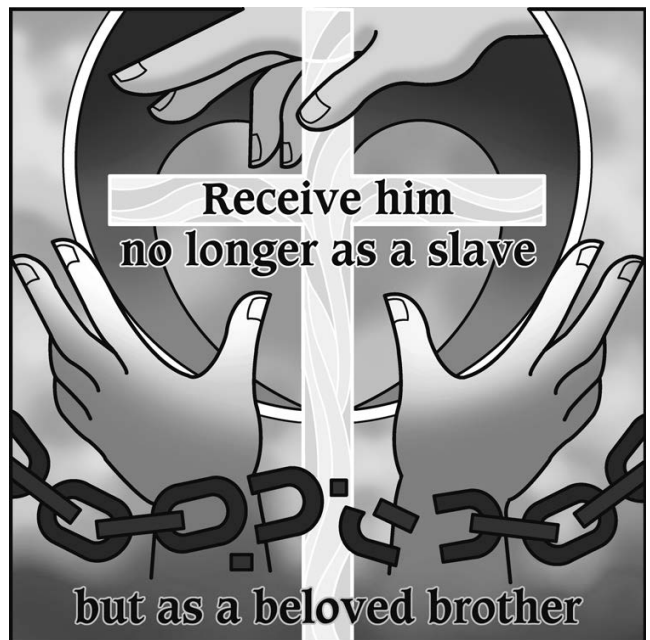
Saturday, September 14, on the Patio, after the 5:00pm Mass. Call the Parish Office to let us know you are planning to attend.
