We deliver non-perishable food items from the parish to Mount Carmel Guild, sponsor a foul-shooting contest for area youth, pass out rosettes to protect the rights of the unborn, coach youth sports, sponsor an annual banquet for our priests, and install the parish Christmas Nativity at the front of the parish property. The Knights have organized and cooked for the annual parish picnic, given over 4,000 hours of service to the church and local community each year, and made numerous fifty visits to the sick and bereaved.
