Dear Parishioner,

I am writing to invite your participation in our Accessibility Improvement Project Capital Campaign. The goal of this campaign is to raise \$220,000 in cash and pledges by January 30. If we are successful, we will be able to join this amount to what has already been raised through the Witness to Hope Campaign and parish savings and proceed with the construction of a new elevator, two new handicap accessible bathrooms upstairs, a small meeting room in the basement, and the conversion of the existing upstairs bathroom and lift shaft into a small sitting area. We believe this will improve accessibility for both our Fellowship Hall as well as our church. Please see the enclosed brochure for further details on our Accessibility Improvement Project.

I am grateful for your generous donations to our Sunday offertory, Witness to Hope Campaign, and Diocesan Services Appeal. If you can make an additional gift to this Capital Campaign, it will allow us to fulfill a long-held hope for many of our parishioners and visitors. Gifts can be made over a five-year pledge period.

We ask that you fill out the enclosed pledge card and return it to the parish by **January 30**. This will allow us to determine whether:

1. We reached our goal of \$220,000; the project can be completed this year.
2. We reached most of our goal; we may be able to complete the elevator this year and provide the groundwork for the remainder of the work to be done later.
3. We did not receive enough; we will continue to build up the funds in a restricted account until we can proceed.

Please pray for the success of our campaign, so that our facilities will have greater accessibility to our parishioners, visitors, and guests. If you have any questions about this campaign, please call me at our parish office.
