<p>CSC Hat & Mitten Tree (Nov. – Dec) Students are invited to donate new hats, mittens, scarves</p>
<p>Lights of St. Mary's - (Dec) Chair – Mary Ankrapp Sell Christmas cards with a prayer and a light on our decorated tree at the school for In Memory Of's and otherwise. Help needed coordinating sales and collection. Lighting of the tree prayer service takes place prior to Christmas Concert</p>
