Registration Priority List

Parents wishing to register their child(ren) in St. Francis Xavier School will have their registration form considered according to the Priority Listing below:

1. Children of registered, active, and supporting parishioners of St. Francis Xavier for more than one year.
2. Children of registered, active, and supporting parishioners of St. Francis Xavier for less than one year.
3. Children of registered, active, and supporting parishioners of other Catholic Church parishes with no school or no room in the school.
4. Children of parents who are registered in another Church parish.
5. Catholic students who are not registered in any Church parish.
6. Non-Catholic students who are open to the Catholic faith.

Please Note:

Parents of Pre-K through 2nd grade applicants will be notified of acceptance after the screening process is completed.

Parents of 3rd through 7th grade applicants will be notified of acceptance after a review of the student's records by and a parent/child interview with the administration.

The Registration Process is not completed until all copies of the following documents are received:

Birth Certificate, Baptism Certificate, First Communion Certificate (if applicable), up-to-date Immunization records, most recent report card, Cumulative Record, and Standardized Test scores.

All necessary fees must be paid for the registration process to be completed.
