

CONFIRMATION COVENANT



The faith community of Annunciation Parish invites you to prepare for your Confirmation in our Catholic Faith. We want you to discover and enjoy the life our parish shares...the life of the Spirit. We care about you, respect you, and want you to be an active member of our Christian community living as a disciple of Jesus. You will receive support and understanding from our Church leaders along with a sponsor and your family to guide you.

If you are willing to take the steps and prepare for a fuller life in the Spirit, come journey with us in the preparation process. Please complete and sign this Covenant...

A covenant is a sacred contract between you and God. Your promise takes the form of your agreement to grow this year in your discipleship. Your sacred covenant is supported by God's love, our parish's love and guidance, and your choice. Your covenant cannot be broken unless you choose to break it. Should you choose to break any part of the contract, you have chosen to delay your reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation until such time that you are ready to make a commitment.

I _____ agree to:

- Regular prayer life, including participation every week at Sunday Mass with the Annunciation community
- Active and consistent participation in class sessions
- Service activities and projects, as a sign of living out my Christian responsibility to love and serve others (20 hours of service with a summary report)
- Parent and teen attendance at the upcoming Fall Meeting
- Write a *Letter to the Pastor* as to why I wish to be Confirmed (due in the Fall)
- Participate at the Sponsor/Parent and teen Session on a Sunday, to be determined, followed by the Inscription Mass at noon
- Participate in the Confirmation interviews (Fall and Spring)
- Participation in the weekend Confirmation retreat in January 2020
- Sharing in special liturgical events planned as part of Confirmation preparation including rehearsal.
- Strive for greater maturity
- Accept more responsibility in my family, my church, and my community.

Having clearly understood what is expected of me as I prepare for Confirmation, I sign this covenant in the presence of God and my parents as witnesses.

I ask the help of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit to assist me in living up to this agreement.
