From The Pastor's Desk Father John Jicha

"Lent is a favorable season for opening the doors to all those in need and recognizing in them the face of Christ." -- **Pope Francis**


Dear Parishioners:

Another Lent is upon us! During this season, we are called to seek a closer relationship with our God, through prayer and reading scripture, via service to others, by sharing our financial resources, and through sacrifices such as fasting.

Many of us know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but I also invite you to practice self-discipline in other ways throughout the season; maybe spend less time in front of the tv or other leisure activity, to free up time for prayer, and service. The tradition of giving of alms to the poor is a great way to share God's gifts; but in addition, maybe this Lent we could share our time and talents at our parishes or with other worthy causes in Washington County to help those in need. Lent is also a fitting time to think about how we interact with others in the world - and recognize that as disciples, we are called to share the compassion and love of God - and be peacemakers in times of conflict and in places of mistrust. I invite you to pray for peace, and recognize that you can be an instrument of God's peace in the home, our neighborhoods and workplaces.

The liturgy committee has chosen "peace" as a watchword for our Pastorate this Lent. Small peace signs will be distributed on Ash Wednesday and the first Sunday of Lent after the masses. I invite you to take one and keep it close at hand, maybe in your pocket or purse, or your dashboard as a frequent reminder that we all want to experience, and be instruments of God's peace.

Do not forget to join us on Friday evenings in Lent: the Fish Fry at St. Joseph and Stations of the Cross in English, and followed by Mass and Stations in Spanish; a Soup Supper after Stations at St. James, and Stations at St. Augustine. Details for these events are in this bulletin.

Desde el escritorio del Padre Juan Antonio

La fe cristiana es historia, no sólo una serie de ideas. La profesión de fe que hacemos en la liturgia no está compuesta de una serie de ideas elevadas de la esencia de Dios, de las cualidades, de los conceptos del hombre o del mundo. El credo de los israelitas, de Jesús y de la comunidad cristiana refleja los altibajos de la historia. El credo de Israel comienza con la historia de Jacob, un arameo errante, y sus descendientes, conducidos por Dios, a través de los siglos, a la tierra prometida. El credo de los cristianos está fundado en la historia de Jesús de Nazaret, resucitado de entre los muertos y hecho Señor por su Padre. Las ideas están para pensar, no para creer. La historia de la salvación debe ser ambas cosas: alimento para el pensamiento y una profesión de fe.

3. Dios quiere dos fidelidades unidas. La liturgia claramente demuestra la increíble fidelidad de Dios hacia el hombre. En medio de los tiempos oscuros y de los momentos aparentemente desesperados de la historia, Dios camina fielmente con su gente en Egipto, en el desierto, y en la tierra le prometió a Abraham (primera lectura). Cuando Cristo es tentado por el diablo y más adelante cuando parece derrotado por la muerte, su Padre le fue fiel. Dios desea unir su fidelidad con la del hombre; Jesús unió su fidelidad a la del Padre de una manera extraordinaria.

Exortación Apostólica Amoris Laetitia

Doy gracias a Dios porque muchas familias, que están lejos de considerarse perfectas, viven en el amor, realizan su vocación y siguen adelante, aunque caigan muchas veces a lo largo del camino. A partir de las reflexiones sinodales no queda un estereotipo de la familia ideal, sino un interpelante «collage» formado por tantas realidades diferentes, colmadas de gozos, dramas y sueños. Las realidades que nos preocupan son desafíos. No caigamos en la trampa de desgastarnos en lamentos autodefensivos, en lugar de despertar una creatividad misionera. En todas las situaciones, «la Iglesia siente la necesidad de decir una palabra de verdad y de esperanza [...] Los grandes valores del matrimonio y de la familia cristiana corresponden a la búsqueda que impregna la existencia humana». Si constatamos muchas dificultades, ellas son —como dijeron los Obispos de Colombia— un llamado a «liberar en nosotros las energías de la esperanza traduciéndolas en sueños proféticos, acciones transformadoras e imaginación de la caridad»

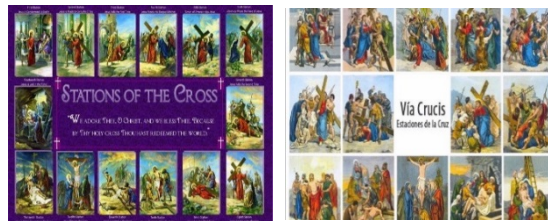

IMPORTANT INFORMATION DURING LENT TIME

There are not marriage celebration or Baptism Celebration during Lent time.

All persons who have reached their 14th birthday are bound by the law of abstinence. All adults are bound by the law to fast up to their 60th year. The current canonical discipline of penance for the United States says; that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast; that is, limited to a single full meal.

MASS CARDS INTENTIONS

Mass Cards are gifts of love and prayers to honor the life and love of a dear one though the celebration of the Holy Mass.

They are a wonderful way to show your friendship to someone who is celebrating a birthday, anniversary, marriage, or going through a difficult time in their life. Cards may be obtained at the Church office during Business hours.
