Dear Parishioners,

As Lent continues, I ask that you mark your calendars for April 8th, which is the day designated by the diocese for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. For our Pastorate on that day, confessions will be held from 10:00 am - 11:15 am at St. James, prior to the 11:30 am mass. At St. Augustine, confessions will be held from 1:00 pm - 2:00 pm on that day. Also, the regional reconciliation service will be hosted at St. Joseph at 7:00 pm. Confessions in both English and Spanish will be available at the regional service.

St. Joseph parishioner Isaac Carder, has been chosen to receive the Msgr. Valenzano Service Award. The award is for High School Altar Servers and Sacristans who have been models of service in the diocese. Desde el escritorio del Padre Juan Antonio

La experiencia de Pedro, Juan y Santiago duró sólo un rato. Sus efectos, sin embargo, permanecieron a lo largo de toda la vida. ¿No fue algo inolvidable y eficazmente transformante? En nuestra vida ha habido y podrá haber momentos también de "transfiguración", de experiencia viva y gratificante de Dios. A veces esa experiencia de Dios se prolonga por un tiempo o incluso una vida, pero con poca frecuencia la intensidad con que se ha experimentado a Dios pasa. Debe, sin embargo, dejar su huella. A esta huella llamo yo "vida transfigurada". En otras palabras, vida de quien ha visto y ve el rostro de Dios en las realidades y acontecimientos de la existencia. Ve el rostro de Dios en ese niño sonriente y activo, como lo ve igualmente en ese otro pequeño minusválido. Mira a Dios en los ojos transparentes de una joven limpia de alma, que ha consagrado a Dios su vida entera; pero lo mira también en los ojos de una prostituta, obligada a ese trabajo forzado para sobrevivir y sostener a sus padres y hermanos. Descubre al Viviente en las especies del pan y del vino, no menos que en las chispas de redención que saltan del pedernal de una conciencia endurecida y pecadora. Todo está transfigurado, porque todo porta consigo de alguna manera la marca original: *made in God*.

Exortación Apostólica *Amoris Laetitia* - Papa Francisco

Doy gracias a Dios porque muchas familias, que están lejos de considerarse perfectas, viven en el amor, realizan su vocación y siguen adelante, aunque caigan muchas veces a lo largo del camino. A partir de las reflexiones sinodales no queda un estereotipo de la familia ideal, sino un interpelante «*collage*» formado por tantas realidades diferentes, colmadas de gozos, dramas y sueños. Las realidades que nos preocupan son desafíos. No caigamos en la trampa de desgastarnos en lamentos autodefensivos, en lugar de despertar una creatividad misionera. En todas las situaciones, «la Iglesia siente la necesidad de decir una palabra de verdad y de esperanza [...] Los grandes valores del matrimonio y de la familia cristiana corresponden a la búsqueda que impregna la existencia humana». Si constatamos muchas dificultades, ellas son —como dijeron los Obispos de Colombia— un llamado a «liberar en nosotros las energías de la esperanza traduciéndolas en sueños proféticos, acciones transformadoras e imaginación de la caridad».
