**From The Pastor's Desk
Father John Jicha**

Dear Parishioners:

People often do not look forward to Lent. Childhood memories of giving up candy or sitting through weekly Stations of the Cross come immediately to mind. Words like “sacrifice,” “discipline,” and “self-denial” are often used in ways that suggest that Lent is something to be endured rather than a time of grace and spiritual growth. But maybe we ought to look at Lent in a different way.

Have you ever thought of Lent as a yearly second chance? Each year the Church gives us six weeks to take a long, loving look at our lives to see if our values and priorities are in line with God's desires for us. Since most of us find that we've wandered from God's path in varying degrees, Lent becomes that second chance, or "do-over", or as we hear in the Ash Wednesday reading from the book of the prophet Joel, to “return to God with our whole hearts.”

As we approach the midpoint of Lent, I invite you to reflect upon that idea of Lent as a "do-over", a second chance (or third, or fourth, etc.) that God generously gives us, to more fully live as Disciples of Christ.

Tercera Domingo de Cuaresma

La plenitud total de Cristo y la participación de todo hombre a esa plenitud no se la han inventado ni el Papa ni los obispos; forma parte de la revelación cristiana. Si a un budista, a un judío, a un musulmán se le pidiese renunciar a parte de sus libros sagrados, o a una doctrina que ellos consideran revelación divina, ¿cómo reaccionarían? ¿Se puede renunciar a algo en lo que el mismo Dios está comprometido? A nosotros, cristianos, se nos pide ser los primeros en mostrar coherencia con la revelación cristiana, que abarca el Antiguo y el Nuevo Testamento. Nosotros, cristianos, por coherencia con nuestra fe, hemos de ser respetuosos con los creyentes de otras religiones, pero hemos de pedir también a los no cristianos el respeto debido a nuestra fe. Sería una buena iniciativa por parte de los cristianos explicar, de modo sencillo y convincente, la pretensión cristiana de la plenitud de Jesucristo: qué es lo que significa, cómo influye en la relación con las otras religiones, en qué manera explica la salvación universal querida por Dios, cómo podemos conocernos mejor unos a otros para evitar así malentendidos, confusión, manipulación... Se habla de diálogo ecuménico, interreligioso, y esto es estupendo, pero, es bien sabido que la base de todo diálogo no puede ser otra sino el respeto de la persona y de la identidad del interlocutor. Digamos la verdad cristiana con caridad, con respeto. Sólo entonces podrá comenzar el diálogo auténtico y fructuoso con quienes busquen y amen la verdad.

Exortación Apostólica Amoris Laetitia

Doy gracias a Dios porque muchas familias, que están lejos de considerarse perfectas, viven en el amor, realizan su vocación y siguen adelante, aunque caigan muchas veces a lo largo del camino. A partir de las reflexiones sinodales no queda un estereotipo de la familia ideal, sino un interpelante «collage» formado por tantas realidades diferentes, colmadas de gozos, dramas y sueños. Las realidades que nos preocupan son desafíos. No caigamos en la trampa de desgastarnos en lamentos autodefensivos, en lugar de despertar una creatividad misionera. En todas las situaciones, «la Iglesia siente la necesidad de decir una palabra de verdad y de esperanza [...] Los grandes valores del matrimonio y de la familia cristiana corresponden a la búsqueda que impregna la existencia humana». Si constatamos muchas dificultades, ellas son —como dijeron los Obispos de Colombia— un llamado a «liberar en nosotros las energías de la esperanza traduciéndolas en sueños proféticos, acciones transformadoras e imaginación de la caridad»
