### From The Pastor's Desk Father John Jicha

This weekend we continue walking these Lenten days toward resurrection of Jesus. Looking beyond old limits to new possibilities is what our Lenten journey is all about. As Easter appears on the horizon, it is wise for us to heed the words of the Apostle Paul in the scriptures, Paul reminds us that we need to walk slowly and with great care, because we have repair work to do within our own hearts and in our world.

St. Paul urged the gathered community in Corinth to expand their vision, to see that “everything has become new” (2 Corinthians 5:17). We tend to focus on what is broken, what is limiting, what is imperfect – both in ourselves and in the world. But what if all the limits we put on people and things were suddenly dismantled? What if we started to see the world through the eyes of Christ, who saw human failings and human differences as opportunities to expand the reign of God? Jesus saw through all barriers and boundaries, and broke them to the point where even death lost all its finality. Jesus saw through brokenness and hopelessness, and poured himself out to the point that his love conquered all. Trusting in Jesus allows us to shed some of our old ways. We can let go of sin and selfishness, greed and self-centeredness to make room for this whole new, resurrected life into which we are called to live. Paul asks his community—and us—to be reconciled, entrusting the ministry of reconciliation to us, as we strive to imitate the Jesus.

Reconciliation involves letting go of our old ways of seeing, and acting upon the vision Jesus wants to share with us. Let us choose - to see ourselves in Jesus' loving eyes, allowing him to dwell deeply within us - that we might fully experience the joy of the Resurrection.

Indeed, “nothing is more solid, profound, secure, meaningful and wise than that message”. In effect, “all Christian formation consists of entering more deeply into the kerygma”.
