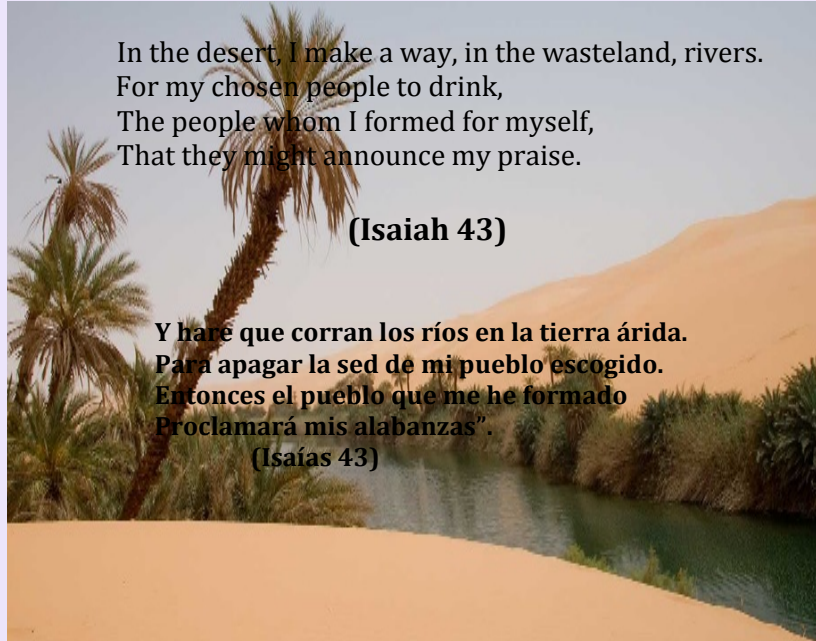

**From The Pastor's Desk
Father John Jicha**

God's abundant forgiveness is demonstrated in this week's gospel, John's account of the encounter between Jesus, the Pharisees, the scribes, and the woman at the well. Seeking to gather evidence against Jesus, the Pharisees and Scribes ask Jesus what should be done to the woman who has been caught in adultery.

Jesus avoids their trap by suggesting that the one without sin cast the first stone. The Pharisees and the Scribes, recognizing that they are sinners and unworthy of passing judgement, disperse, one by one. Jesus, demonstrating the profound mercy of God, also refuses to pass judgement upon the adulterous woman, and sends her on her way, with the advice to avoid sinful behavior in the future.

During these last weeks of Lent, we are invited to ponder the great gift of God's forgiveness, recognizing with humility of heart that all of us are sinners, and none of us are fit to judge others. Jesus invites us to seek reconciliation with the Father, and as with the woman at the well, Jesus calls us to sin no more.

One of the great blessings of our Catholic faith is the sacrament of Reconciliation, to help us grow in God's forgiveness and mercy. I invite you to partake of the sacrament at our regional Reconciliation service on Monday, April 8th, at 7:00 pm at St. Joseph.
