**From The Pastor's Desk

This Sunday is referred to as Palm or Passion Sunday, and begins Holy Week. Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday are called the Triduum, (in latin), which means the three days, that signify the pinnacle of our liturgical year. There are two Gospels proclaimed at mass on Palm Sunday. The first Gospel, proclaimed before the procession with palms, tells of Jesus' triumphant entrance into Jerusalem. Riding on a colt, Jesus was greeted by enthusiastic crowds. The second Gospel proclaimed on Palm Sunday is Jesus' passion, this year read from Luke's Gospel. We will hear these events proclaimed again during the Triduum when we read the passion of Jesus from the Gospel of John.

Throughout Holy Week, I invite you to upon present at our parishes to participate in and reflect on the events of Jesus' passion and death. See the schedule of Triduum services listed in this bulletin. As we meditate on the cross, we ponder anew what it means to believe that Jesus, in his suffering and dying, revealed himself as God's Son and brought to fulfillment the Kingdom.

Mis queridos Hermanos en Cristo Jesús.

Hoy con alegría y Jubilo celebramos el domingo de Ramos de la pasión del Señor, comenzamos la Semana Mayor, la semana santa, la liturgia de este domingo nos invita a contemplar a Cristo triunfante hacia la ciudad santa de Jerusalén, llamados a proclamar y a reconocerlo como Rey: San Lucas nos describe el júbilo de las persona: “ conforme iban avanzando, extendían sus mantos por el camino, cerca de la bajado del monte de los Olivos, toda la multitud de los discípulos, llenos de alegría, se pusieron a alabar a Dios a grandes voces, por todos los milagros que habían visto decían: ¡Bendito el Rey que viene en nombre del Señor! Y así, hecho uno de ellos, se humillo así mismo y por obediencia acepto incluso la muerte, y una muerte de Cruz.” Fil. 2, 7-8. Salgamos al encuentro del Rey proclamemos agradecidos sus maravillas, porque si nosotros no lo hacemos nos dirá “sino llamamos las Piedras Gritaran” Cfr. Lucas. 19, 40. Queridos hermanos: “que las puertas levantes sus dinteles, levanten los portones antiguos de nuestro corazón, para que entre el Rey de la gloria.” Cfr. Salmo 24, 7.
