Happy Easter!

In our scriptures this weekend, after sharing the last supper with Jesus and the disciples, and after witnessing Jesus' suffering and death on the cross, Mary Magdalene goes to the tomb early on Sunday morning. We journey with Mary to see that the stone covering the tomb has been moved; the tomb is empty! We experience with her the beginnings of hope, and the realization that something miraculous has happened. The Savior is risen!

How do we react? Do we, like Mary Magdalene, go forth announcing the good news of resurrection? Or, are our hearts like a tomb still waiting for the resurrection? Can we identify any "gravestone" that is holding us back from a fuller, freer life? It could be a failed relationship, addiction, a illness, or an old hurt we have never shared with anyone - anything that weighs us down or blocks us from being the happy people our God wants us to be. But as pope Francis said in his Easter message, we are meant to be "people of joyful hope, not doomsday prophets, mired in the past!"

Let us hear the good news of Jesus' resurrection anew today! And let us trust in Him, and the healing that he brings. We embrace the hope and joy that is only found in Jesus, and go out to share them with others.
