From The Pastor's Desk
Father John Jicha

In John's Gospel this weekend, the disciples have brought to shore a tremendous catch of fish that the Resurrected Jesus directed them to find. But once on the shore, they see that Jesus has already prepared fish and bread on a campfire on the beach. Jesus serves them and is host of the meal that follows. In this we are meant to see a reference to the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and the fishes. And, we are also meant to see a connection to us, as we gather for the celebration of the Eucharist in our pastorate. When we celebrate the Eucharist, we too are fed by Jesus in the bread and wine that have become his Body and Blood. We also find in this story insight about the presentation of the gifts at Mass. The gifts we bring to the altar, bread and wine, are made from the abundance of blessings that God has given to us: grain and grapes, the fruit of the earth. God accepts the offering we bring—bread and wine, “the work of human hands”—and transforms our offering into the gift of his real presence in the Eucharist.

The gospel passage comes to a dramatic high point after the meal, when Jesus addresses Simon Peter. This conversation is a gentle confrontation, an acknowledgement of Peter's three denials of Jesus during his passion. Jesus offers reconciliation to Peter, and gives him a mission: “Feed my lambs . . . Tend my sheep . . . Feed my sheep.” These commands empower Peter, from that moment forward to embrace the ministry of Jesus, even sacrificing himself for the flock. As Jesus has fed Peter in this meal and as Jesus feeds us in the Eucharist, so he also sends us to follow him, asking that we offer our lives in service and sacrifice.

Desde el escritorio del Pastor Padre John Jicha

En el Evangelio de Juan este fin de semana, los discipulos han traído la temenda encomienda de pesca que recojieron cuando Jesús Resucitado les envió a realizar. Pero una vez terminada la encomienda, ellos vierón que Jesús habia preparado pescado y pan en la orilla de la playa. Jesús como anfitrión les sirve la comida. En esto miramos como referencia el milagro de la multiplicación de panes y peces. Y también miramos la conección que esto tiene con nosotros, cuando nos reunimos a Celebrar la Eucaristia en nuestra parroquia. Cuando nosotros Celebramos la Eucaristia, nosotros tambien somos alimentados por Jesús con Pan y Vino que se han convertido en su Cuerpo y en Su Sangre. También encontramos que en la Presentación de las Ofrendas en la Misa. Las Ofrendas que traemos al Altar, pan y vino, son hechas de la abundacia de bendiciones que Dios nos ha dado: trigo y uvas, son el fruto de la tierra. Dios acepta el ofrecimiento que le hacemos de pan y vino, “El trabajo de los hombres” y transforma nuestra ofrenda en el regalo de su Real Presencia en la Eucaristia.

El pasaje del Evangelio nos trae un punto bien dramatico después de la comida, cuando Jesús se dirige a Pedro. Esta conversación es una confrontación suave, y sabiendo que Pedro lo habia negado tres veces durante su Pasión. Jesús le ofrece reconciliación a Pedro, y le da una misión: “alimenta mis Corderos...Cuida mis ovejas...Alimenta mis Ovejas.” Estos mandatos fortalezen a Pedro, desde ese momento en adelante a abrazar el Ministerio de Jesús, hasta sacrificarse a el mismo por los demás. Asi como Jesús alimentó a Pedro y a nosotros con la Eucaristia, nos esta embiando a seguirle a El, pidiendonos que ofrescamos nuestras vidas al Servicio y al Sacrificio.
