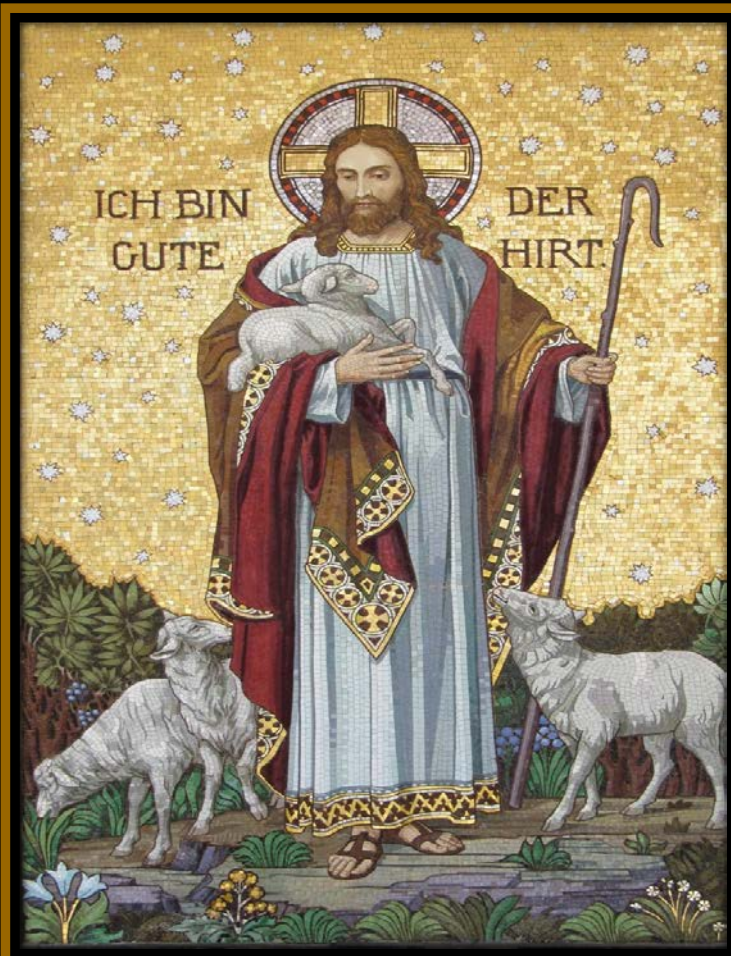

### **From The Pastor's Desk Father John Jicha**

The fourth Sunday of Easter is called Good Shepherd Sunday. In each of the three-lectionary cycles, the Gospel is taken from the tenth chapter of the Gospel of John, which paints for us a mental picture for us of Jesus as our Good Shepherd. The image of Jesus as Good Shepherd and the community of followers as his sheep has endured over the centuries as a primary image in our faith tradition. Today most of us do not have the same experience with shepherds and sheep, as did the people of Jesus' day. However, the image of Jesus as our Shepherd remains a powerful way to describe the relationship between Jesus and us, his followers. The image speaks to us about the protection, security, and care that shepherds represent for their sheep. Thinking of Jesus as our Good Shepherd helps us understand the abiding love that our God has for us.

Today's Gospel speaks powerfully about the familiarity and intimacy between Jesus and his disciples, expressed as recognizing and knowing another's voice. Today's Gospel also speaks to the relationship between Jesus and the Father. To the Gospel writer, Jesus is identified so closely with the Father that he tells us that they are one—not just close, but actually one. To know Jesus is to know the Father. Jesus does not just bring us closer to the Father, Jesus puts us directly into contact with God the Father, removing all distance between us. Our relationship with Jesus is an invitation to share intimately in the life of God.

#### **Domingo IV de Pascua: Mis queridos Hermanos en Cristo Jesús. Hoy celebramos el Domingo IV de Pascua,**

Domingo del buen Pastor, “Jesús es el buen Pastor que da la vida por amor a sus ovejas”, Crf. Juan 10, 11 “Él nos dice: “Mis ovejas escuchan mi voz; yo las conozco y ellas me siguen”. Juan 10, 14. Nosotros somos Ovejas de Jesús el buen Pastor, hemos sido comprados a precio de su Sangre, por lo tanto, estamos llamados a escuchar y a poner en practica esa voz, que nos trae palabras de vida Eterna, debemos de ser dóciles a su voz en actitud de obediencia y de fe, nosotros ovejas de su rebaño estamos llamados a no rechazar esa buena nueva que nos trae la salvación. En Antioquia vemos como el pueblo judío, no escucha, vemos como rechaza la buena nueva de salvación: “La palabra de Dios debía ser predicada primero a ustedes; pero como la rechazan y no se juzgan dignos de la vida eterna, nos dirigiremos a los paganos. Así nos lo ha ordenado el Señor, cuando dijo: Yo te he puesto como luz de los paganos, para que llesves la salvación hasta los últimos rincones de la tierra”. Pablo y Bernabé se sacudieron el polvo de los pies, como señal de protesta, y se marcharon a Iconio”. Hechos 13, 46-51 El apocalipsis describe la suerte de las ovejas fieles al buen pastor que escuchan su voz, que lo conocen a Él y que lo siguen: Ya no sufrirán hambre ni sed, no los quemará el sol ni los agobiará el calor. Porque el Cordero, que está en el trono, será su pastor y los conducirá a las fuentes del agua de la vida y Dios enjugará de sus ojos toda lágrima” Apocalipsis 7, 16-17. Jesús nos ha dicho: “Yo les doy la vida eterna y no perecerán jamás; nadie las arrebatará de mi mano”. Juan 10, 28.
