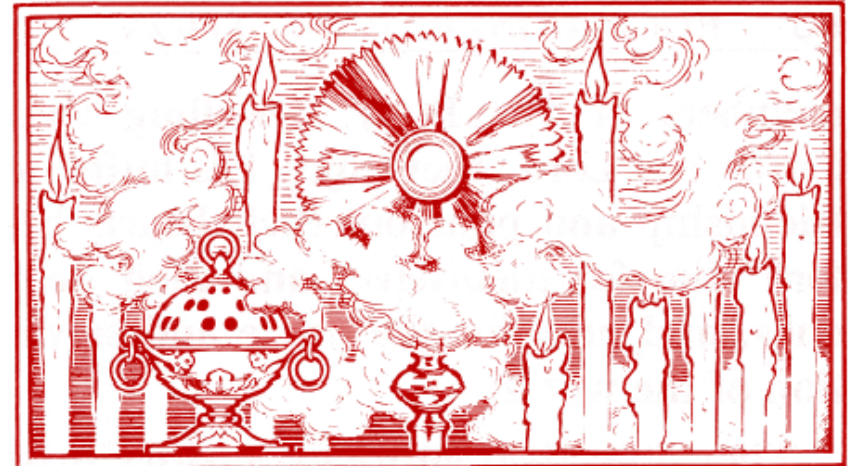

Emmanuel, God with us, the promise of the Lord at the Ascension that “I am with you always, even to the end of the world.
