

And he said to them, "Well did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites, as it is written,

'This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me; in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines the precepts of men.'

Mark 7:6-7

Have you ever known the person who always has all the right answers, they always seem to have everything "just so", but something in the back of your mind tells you that something isn't quite right? I have worked for a few commanders who were this way. They could always butter up the top brass, and seemed destined for higher levels of command, but you wouldn't trust them to lead you into a Walmart! What was wrong with these? They knew the book answers but did not truly understand the why - the reasons were in their heads not in their hearts. They were more concerned with how they looked than the Soldiers under their command. These are the spiritual leaders that our Lord chastised in our passage from Mark. However, commanders are not the only ones to fall into this trap. How many times can you remember hearing someone say, "do as I say, not as I do..." This mentality is a fatal error in the Christian life. We must remember that true faith, and true worship come from the inside, if we are to get the most from the walk of faith, we must live it each minute of each day.
