The rosary is prayed each weekday morning after the 7:00 a.m. Mass. All are welcome.



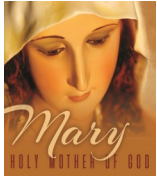
WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY

ROSARY DEVOTION TO OUR BLESSED MOTHER.



May is the month dedicated to praying the rosary in honor of our Blessed Mother. The origin of the Rosary dates back to St. Dominic, when our Blessed Lady appeared to him and asked him to teach the people how to pray the Rosary (1208). Since then it has become a world wide devotion and saints like St. Padre Pio have called this devotion of the Rosary, "the greatest weapon against Satan." Here at Sacred Heart we continue this family tradition of teaching and praying the Rosary. We invite everyone, especially families, to come and join us in keeping the Blessed Mother's request to pray the rosary daily. Our devotion will take place on the following dates: **Wednesday evening May 30th**. All devotions will start at **7:00 PM** in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph, and will include Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. First Friday Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Friday, June 1, 2018, is the First Friday of the month. **June is also the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.**

Traditionally, in our parish, every First Friday of the month is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Make this month the time to dedicate your whole family to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Our day begins with the celebration of **Mass at 7AM**, in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph, followed by exposition and adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament until 12 Noon. The rosary is prayed every hour on the half hour beginning at 7:30 AM.. At **12 NOON. Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament will take place along with the recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.** All are invited to come anytime during these hours for your personal time with Jesus. **Especially do we encourage our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to spend some time in prayer before the REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS in the Holy Eucharist** as part of their spiritual development.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus also serves as a reminder for one to receive the Sacrament of Penance (Confession). The Sacrament of Penance may also be requested any day, following morning Mass, by coming to the Sacristy. Confession is also available from **8 AM to 3 PM** weekdays (except Thursday) at the rectory or by appointment. Saturday confessions are scheduled **3-3:30 PM** in the upper church.

We encourage all Altar Servers, Lectors and Ministers of the Eucharist to kindly get a replacement if you find that you are unable to fulfill your scheduled weekend obligation.
