to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

July 6th is the **First Friday** of the month. Traditionally in our parish every First Friday of the month is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. On Friday, the day begins with the celebration of **Mass at 7AM**, in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph, followed by exposition and adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament until 12 Noon. The rosary is prayed every hour on the half hour beginning at **7:30 AM**. At **12 NOON Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament will take place along with the recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy**. All are invited to come anytime during these hours for your spiritual enrichment and your personal time with Jesus. **We especially encourage our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to spend some time in prayer before the REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS** as part of their spiritual development. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus also serves as a reminder for one to receive the Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation). The Sacrament of Reconciliation may also be requested each day, following morning Mass, by coming to the Sacristy. Confession is also available from **8 a.m. to 3 p.m.** each weekday except Thursday at the rectory or by appointment. Saturday confessions are scheduled 3-3:30 p.m. in the upper church.

NEW PIPE ORGAN IN THE CHAPEL OF THE HOLY SPOUSES MARY AND JOSEPH AND MEMORIAL GIFTS

After a three year period of searching for a replacement of the failing electric organ that has served the lower church for well over fifty years, our parish purchased a continuo organ crafted in 2003 by Klop Orgelbau of Garderen, Netherlands through the Harpsichord Clearance House of Rehoboth, MA. This rather small pipe organ, also known as a positivity organ, consists of one manual (keyboard) and twenty-seven pedals and is designed primarily to accompany voices and instruments although it can play a portion of the organ repertoire that does not require an elaborate registration. In addition to its beautiful tone and artistic appearance this organ does not hinder the view of the sanctuary and is actually smaller than its predecessor. As a pipe organ it will appreciate in value and with expert care will be playable for many generations.

Due to the sacred use of the organ in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses Mary and Joseph parishioners are kindly invited to consider making a donation in their names or in the memory of their faithful departed. Donations of **\$250 or more** would be gratefully accepted yet no gift would be refused. A **memorial plaque** will be placed in the chapel to acknowledge the generosity of parishioners and other donors.
