

August - First Friday Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Friday, August 3, 2018, is the First Friday

of the month. Traditionally in our parish every First Friday of the month is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. On Friday, our day begins with the celebration of Mass at 7AM, in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph, followed by exposition and adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament until 12 Noon. The rosary is prayed every hour on the half hour beginning at 7:30 AM. At 12 NOON Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament will take place along with the recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. All are invited to come anytime during these hours for your spiritual enrichment and your personal time with Jesus. Especially we encourage our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to spend some time in prayer before the REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS as part of their spiritual development. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus also serves as a reminder for one to receive the Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation). The Sacrament of Reconciliation may be requested each day following morning Mass by coming to the Sacristy. Confession is also available from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. each weekday at the rectory by appointment. Saturday confessions are scheduled 3-3:30 p.m. in the upper church.

We encourage all Altar Servers, Lectors and Ministers of the Eucharist to kindly get a replacement if you find that you are unable to fulfill your scheduled weekend obligation.
