The vision of Holy Family Catholic School is to partner with parents and/or guardians to insure that every child is successful in achieving excellent yearly academic and faith progress: to take pride in themselves, their faith, school and community, and to prepare them for their lifelong journey in serving God here on earth and into eternity.

Today we say, "See you later!" to our 8th graders. It has been a joy to watch them grow in their faith, academic, and social lives. These students may be one of the most talkative bunches, but they are also passionate and hard-working. We know they will do well in the next chapter in their lives. As Saint Catherine of Siena said, "Be who God meant you to be and you will set the world on fire."

Over the summer there are several ways you can help your child continue to grow in their faith and academics.

- -Encourage your child to make time for God. Your child can pray the rosary, spend time in personal meditation, or attend Mass. Sacred Heart offers Mass on Tuesday, and Thursday at 8:00 am. and Wednesday and Fridays at 6:30am, Our Lady of Guadalupe offers Mass Tuesday through Friday at 8:00 am.
- -Set aside time for your student to read each day during the summer break -- 15 to 30 minutes per day is all it takes! Don't stop there! Ask your child to take ownership of their reading comprehension by writing a summary, creating a movie advertisement, doing a character analysis, or designing comprehension questions.
- -Working on just three to four math problems per day during the summer can prevent students' mathematical skills from getting rusty. There are many websites that offer fun and engaging activities that review math concepts. Check our Holy Family's website for some suggestions.
- -Creative writing is a great way to improve your children's written language skills while giving them a fun and imaginative activity during the summer! Have your student write a creative paragraph each week, a poem, or short story.
